



14 Days Best Of Kuching

Valid Till : 31 Mar 2018

Day 1 : Arrive Kuching

Arrive Kuching Airport, meet and transfer to Abell Hotel / Lime Tree Hotel (3 star). Check in. Overnight.

Day 2 : Semenggoh Orang Utan / City Tour

Morning, depart to Semenggoh Orang Utan Rehabilitation Centre situated about ½ hour drive from Kuching, here, the orang utans are being nurtured to readapt themselves to the jungle life. You will have the chance to observe the Semi-Wild Orang Utans coming out of the forest for the feeding time. Visitors are allowed to study and observe the orang utans at a distance.

Depart park and proceed for lunch at local restaurant.

After lunch, depart for Kuching city tour to see most of the places of attraction around this historical city. Drive to see the gigantic cat statue, the mascot of Kuching city at Padungan before cruising through China Town. Stop at the Tua Pek Kong Temple, one of the oldest temples in Sarawak. Pass by the traditional Malay houses built on stilts. Winding through the heart of the city, look out for a majestic looking Astana, the former palace of White Rajah, but now the official residence of the Governor of Sarawak, the old Colonial Law Court House. Then, pass through the Clock Tower and a granite obelisk built in memory of Rajah Charles Brooke. Visit to the Sarawak Museum. Return to Abell hotel / Lime Tree Hotel. Overnight. (Breakfast/Lunch included)

Day 3 : Bako National Park / Nature Trails / Overnight

Morning, pick up from your hotel and depart for a 45 minute drive to Bako Fishing Village. Continue by boat for a 30 minute cruise along the coast to reach Bako National Park. Upon arrival at the park, registered names and check into basic accommodations. Visit the Park's information centre and follow the trails to look for proboscis monkeys, bearded pigs, silver leaf monkeys and various species of carnivorous pitcher plants and wild orchids. Dinner and overnight at Park guesthouse (Room with fan). (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner included)

Remarks: Please note that accommodation at park is basic (Room with fan).

Day 4 : Nature Trails / Kuching

Morning, proceed on a nature trail in search of wildlife. Lunch at Park cafe. Depart the National Park and return to Kuching. Transfer back to Abell Hotel / Lime Tree Hotel. Overnight.
(Breakfast / Lunch included)

Day 5 : Matang Wildlife / Kubah National Park

Morning, depart to Matang Wildlife Centre, part of Kubah National Park, houses endangered wildlife in large enclosed areas of rainforest or spacious cages. The main attraction is the Orang utan adoption program, where young orang utans, who were either orphaned or rescued from captivity, are taught how to survive in the wild. The centre also houses some other species of animals and endangered birds.

Proceed to Kubah National Park. Kubah's most famous feature is its palms. Almost a hundred different palm species can be found in an area of just over 22 sq km, making Kubah probably the richest palm habitat for its size anywhere in the world. Pack Lunch will be served. Proceed on the nature trails with guide.

Depart park and return to your hotel. Overnight at Abell Hotel / Lime Tree Hotel. (Breakfast/Pack Lunch included)

Day 6 : Kuching / Lemanak Iban Longhouse

Morning, pick up from your hotel and depart for a four hour drive to the jetty. There will be three stop-overs en-route at Serian – a Dayak trading town, a Chinese farmhouse to see how pepper and cocoa are grown and Lachau for lunch. On arrival at the river jetty, proceed by motorized longboat up river to the Longhouse. Afternoon, tour the longhouse and watch the natives at work making mats, baskets, handicrafts and mending fishing nets. After dinner, join in the fun filled evening with the traditional dance and enjoy the locally brewed rice wine known as 'Tuak'. Overnight at the longhouse. (Breakfast /Lunch/Dinner included)

Remarks: Very basic accommodation at longhouse. Mattress, pillow, blanket & mosquito net provided. Sleeping in the 'Ruai', communal covered walkway of the longhouse (No guesthouse)

Day 7 : Blowpipe demo / picnic lunch / Kuching

After breakfast, witness and participate in the blow pipe demonstration and a guided nature walk which gives you an opportunity to learn about some medicinal plants, edible fruits and leaves, the agricultural activities of the community and some game traps used in the past for trapping animals. We will stop by the river beach for a backwoods style picnic lunch where our foods are cooked in bamboo. After lunch, depart by longboat back to the jetty and continue overland drive back to Kuching. Check in Abell Hotel / Lime Tree Hotel. Overnight.
(Breakfast/picnic lunch included)

Day 8 : Kuching / Mulu National Park / Deer and Lang Caves

Pick up and transfer to KCH Apt for flight to Mulu.

Upon arrival at Mulu Apt, meet and transfer to Mulu Park Accommodation. Check into accommodation (Longhouse Room).

Afternoon, depart for a three KM plank walk to Deer Cave and Lang Cave. Late afternoon, observe the millions of bats coming out from the vast mouth of the Deer Cave which will be a memorable occurrence during fine weather. Return to accommodation for overnight. (Breakfast included).

Day 9: Wind & Clearwater Caves / Penan Settlement

Depart by a long boat going up river to Wind Cave via Penan settlement. Visit the settlement and observe the lifestyle of this tribe.

Visit Wind Cave and explore the limestone formation of this unique eco system. Continue the journey to Clearwater Cave where more interesting stone formation can be seen. Picnic lunch at Clear water summer huts. Return to and overnight at Mulu Park accommodation. (Breakfast/Picnic Lunch included)

Day 10: Mulu / Kota Kinabalu / Dinner & Cultural show

Breakfast. Transfer to Mulu airport for your departure flight.

Upon arrival at Kota Kinabalu Airport, meet and transfer to Horizon Hotel (3 star). Check in.

Evening, depart for local seafood dinner with cultural performance. After dinner, return to hotel. Overnight.

(Breakfast / Dinner included)

Day 11 : Kinabalu Park / Poring Hot Spring / Canopy Walk

Morning, depart on a 2hr scenic drive across the Crocker Range to Kinabalu Park (gazetted as a World Heritage site) with its magnificent focal point, Mt Kinabalu, standing at 4095.2m. Brief stop at Nabalu handicraft and fruits stalls.

At Park HQ, visit the Exhibit centre and join the guided nature walk through lowland montane forest. At Poring Hot Springs, trek through a hill dipterocarp forest and experience a jungle-canopy walk 40m above ground. Have a dip in outdoor tubs filled with hot sulphur spring water (if time permit). Depart park and check into accommodation.

Dinner included. Overnight. (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner included)

Day 12 : Sabah Tea Factory / Overland to Sukau, Kinabatangan / River Cruise

After breakfast, depart to Sabah Tea Garden for an educational tour of the tea factory. Then embark on a 4hr journey overland to Kinabatangan. In the late afternoon, take a boat cruise along the longest river in Sabah, Kinabatangan River (560km) to search for primates such as long tailed macaques, pig tailed macaques, proboscis monkeys, wild orangutans, pygmy elephants, gibbons, and other birds and wildlife. Overnight at Sukau Rainforest Lodge. (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner included)

Day 13 : Gomantong Cave / Sepilok Orang Utan Center

After breakfast, depart lodge and visit Gomantong Caves located in a massive limestone outcrop, a shelter for bats and swiftlets which are a source of edible birds nest. Then we continue to Sepilok Orang Utan Sanctuary located in the 4300 hectare Kabili-Sepilok Forest Reserve to learn about how young orphaned or captive apes are rehabilitated for life in the wild with a chance to watch their feeding at 3:00pm. Overnight at Sepilok Nature Resort. (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner included)

Day 14 : Sandakan City Tour / Departure

After breakfast, proceed to Sandakan for a short city tour to a local fish/vegetable market and the Sim Sim water village before drop off at Sandakan airport for your departure flight. (Breakfast included)
