Hanimadhoo is located in the North and it is one of the most beautiful islands of Maldives: lush vegetation, long beaches and turquoise lagoon. Hanimaadhoo Infrastructure

Apart from the international airport, there is a village on the island that takes up about one third of the island. Hanimadhoo community services: school, mosque, health center, climate observatory, local village, police station, airport.

It is planned that this island will soon become an important tourist center of the northern province of Maldives.

Activities in Hanimaadhoo

If the only thing you want is solitude and Maldivian beauty to enjoy, then this island is definitely what you need. A long beach, turquoise water, lots of green plants and practically no tourists - this is what you can find on the island.

Besides, the following activities are available there:

- Snorkeling (day and night) from the boat
- Diving
- Dolphin watching
- Cycling and walking around the island
- Kayaking (a great opportunity to admire the whole island)
- Manta ray watching
- Fishing (night and morning)
- Excursions to the neighboring inhabited and uninhabited islands and resorts
- There are several local islands near Hanimadhoo, where you can get by local ferry

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
