The belief is that the name was given as travelers and soldiers from the 19th century, travelled from the main ports, Port Louis and Grand Port (South East) to refill their pipes in Curepipe..... -Trou aux Cerfs: Located in Curepipe, crater of the dormant volcano offering a panoramic view of -Floreal: Only a few minutes away from Curepipe, Floreal Square is a beautiful place to go for shopping. Adamas, for duty free jewellery, Floreal Square for textile, Voilier de L'Océan for ship models... -Grand Bassin: A lake situated in a mountain area, deep in the lush area of Mauritius. It is the most sacred Hindu place on the island where many pilgrims walk from their homes to collect its water to offer to Lord Shiva for the Maha Shivaratri celebration. -Black River Gorges: A 6,500 hectare park proclaimed natural reserve in 1994 and is the largest national park in Mauritius. From Plaine Champagne on the central plateau there is a breathtaking view of the Black River Gorges where we protect much of the remaining indigenous forests of Mauritius. -Rhumerie de Chamarel: Nestled in the lowland of Chamarel, you will learn about the fermentation and distillation of agricultural rums. -Chamarel Seven Coloured Earth: Created by volcanic rocks that cooled at different temperatures offering hillsides of patterns of colour.
