Discover tradition of Mauritius by following the road of tea.



The Tea Route is an excursion into three key stages: the Domaine des Aubineaux, honey Woods and the Domaine Saint Aubin, allowing you to travel the south of Mauritius and to immerse yourself in local traditions and gastronomy

You will visit the Domaine des Aubineaux and gardens. Le Domaine des Aubineaux is a colonial house built in 1872, which was converted into a museum dedicated to the history of the Mauritian tea.

You will discover, in other furniture from the 17th century and a large collection of photos of colonial houses that were demolished. There are also several displays explaining the important role played by the tea industry during this time.

After visiting the house, you will continue the tour and visit the gardens - the camphor garden. Strolling through the camphor garden, take a look at the diversity of exotic plants as well as trees endemic forests and admire the wonderful view of the tea plantations and the surrounding nature at breath-taking. After visiting the garden you have a small break in the famous tea room and enjoy the delicious buffet of tea and scones.

The tour will continue with a tour of Bois Chéri is the second stop. Bois cherished is the first and largest tea producer in Mauritius, operating since 1892.

After a guided tour of the factory, you will discover the history of tea while visiting the museum of tea production. Nowadays Bois Chéri produces a new variety of flavoured tea, green tea and herbal teas. You can do the tasting during your visit while enjoying a panoramic view of the south of the Island.

Then you will continue your tour with a third stop - home St Aubin. Built in 1819, it was the home of several directors of the sugar plantation before being renovated in the 90s in order to preserve part of the Mauritian heritage. Today one can still see the beams and ship poles used in its original construction.

You can also discover the process of transformation of the vanilla orchid, the flower to the aromatic pod.
