- **Get to know:** Culture, History, Local living of people in Yangon City, Bago, Kyaikhtiyo City and Thanlyin City. Enjoy Myanmar Cuisine. Firstly, Yangon (formerly known as Rangoon) is the largest city in Myanmar (formerly Burma). A mix of British colonial architecture, modern high-rises and gilded Buddhist pagodas define its skyline. Its famed Shwedagon Paya, a huge, shimmering pagoda complex, draws thousands of pilgrims annually. The city's other notable religious sites include the Botataung and Sule pagodas, both housing Buddhist relics. Secondly, Bago is one of the richest archaeological sites in Myanmar. Apparently Mons were the first to settle at this site. Two Mon brothers Thamala and Wimala from Thaton, first founded the city about 825 A.D. In 13th century A.D. The site, which was then on the Gulf of Martaban, had already been earmarked as the location of a great city by Gautama, the historic Buddha. Bago was made the capital of the Mon Kingdom and it came to be known as Hansavati (Hanthawaddy). It was also the seaport of ancient Mon kings. Then it became the Second Myanmar Empire founded by King Bayinnaung. Thirdly, explore Kyaikhtiyo - a small town in Mon State, Myanmar, famous for its Kyaikhtiyo Pagoda or Golden Rock – a favorite destination for travelers. Travelers from near and far come to visit this place, as they considered Kyaikhtiyo as a sacred place like other pagodas in Myanmar. Finally, Only 30 minutes' driver from Yangon across the Bago River, Thanlyin was a major port from the 14 th to the century, until it was displaced by Yangon in 1755, and was briefly controlled by the Portuguese adventures de Brito at the beginning of the 17 th century. The ruins of a Catholic Church built by an Italian Baunabite missionary in the 18 th century can still be seen in Thanlyin. Kyaikkhauk Pagoda in Thanlyin and Yele Pagoda at Kyauktan are some of the places of interest.

SIGHTSEEINGS:



Kyauktiyo Pagoda: also known as Golden Rock and is a well-known Buddhist pilgrimage site in Mon State, Myanmar. It is a small pagoda (7.3 metres (24 ft)) built on the top of a granite boulder covered with gold leaves pasted on by devotees. According to legend, the Golden Rock itself is precariously perched on a strand of the Buddha's hair.



Shwethalyaung Pagoda: is one of the largest reclining Buddha images in Burma. It is housed in the Shwethalyaung Paya in Bago, an important pilgrimage site for Buddhists who come here to pay homage to the Buddha.



Kyauk Khat Wine Monastery: one of the largest monasteries in the country.



Bago: Its former name Pegu is an Anglicism. It is one of the major historical cities in Myanmar as it was the capital of the second Myanmar Empire. Even before that, it has long been a seat of power and flourishing trade center.



Kyaikpun Paya: built in 1476 by King Dhammazedi, it consists of four 30m-high sitting Buddhas placed back-to-back around a huge, square pillar.



Shwemawdaw Pagoda: this is one of the most venerated pagodas in Myanmar. The temple has a 1000-year history and was originally built by 2 merchants, Taphussa and Bhalita, to house some hair relics of the Buddha.



Shwedagon Pagoda: is the most sacred and impressive Buddhist site for the people of the Union of Myanmar. Shwedagon Pagoda is covered with hundreds of gold plates and the top of the stupa is encrusted with 4531 diamonds; the largest of which is a 72 carat diamond. It is clearly one of the wonders of the religious world. The Buddhist site forms the focus of religious as well as community activities: bustling of devotees, monks washing statues, offering flowers, worshipping and meditating



Sule Pagoda: is an important Yangon landmark. Smack right in the centre of a busy commercial district, on the thoroughfare between two major roads, Sule Pagoda has historical and cultural significance. The temple is believed to have been built during the time of the Buddha Guatama and is therefore more than 2,500 years old. It contains a single hair relic of the Buddha.



Kaba Aye Pagoda: mostly known as "World Peace Pagoda" was built in 1952 and was built to commemorate the Sixth Buddha Synod in 1954.



Chauk Htat Gyi Pagoda: an image of a reclining Buddha , 216ft in length and it is the third largest reclining Buddha in Myanmar. One significant thing is that, the eyes of this Buddha are made of glass and look like real human eyes. Chauk Htat Gyi reclining Buddha is the most elegant reclining Buddha image in the world.

Thanlyin: had been the base for the notorious Portuguese adventurer Philip De Brito between 1500s and early 1600s. He ruled over Thanlyin for about 13 years. Actually, he was officially a trade representative for Rakhine (Arakan), but he ran his own little kingdom in Thanlyin, siding with the Mon in their struggle against the Burmese. In the year 1599, he occupied Bago, but in 1613, the Bama King Alaungpaya besieged Thanlyin and impaled him and King Natshin Naung to death. King Alaungpaya

destroyed Thanlyin completely in the year 1756. Today, nothing of this ancient city is to be seen. There are two tombs of Minister Padetha Raza and the great soldier-poet Natshin Naung, King of Ratus



Yele Pagoda: A floating Pagoda which is Pagoda on a small island in



Bogyoke Aung San Market (formerly Scott's Market): is a major bazaar located in Pabedan township in central Yangon, Myanmar. Known for its colonial architecture and inner cobblestone streets, the market is a major tourist destination, dominated by antique, Burmese handicraft and jewellery shops, art galleries, and clothing stores.

minutes to Pagoda. Arrival **Kyaikhtiyo Pagoda** (Golden Rock Pagoda) clients can visit & praying. Then afternoon drive to base camp by open light truck car. Arrive at base camp around 4 PM Overnight at Kyaikhtiyo.
