4 Days Yangon - Bago - Golden Rock

Day 1 YANGON ARRIVAL

On arrival you will be welcomed by tour guide and drive to hotel for check in. Overnight at hotel in Yangon. (Meals excluded)





After breakfast at hotel deive to Kveikhtivo (Golden Rock). Kveikhtivo Pagoda; also known as Golden Rock, 160 Km (about 5 hrs) from Yangon and 1,100 meters (3,600 ft) above sea level. On the way visit the four seated Buddhas at Kyaikpun Pagoda, the 180 feet (55m) long Shwe Thar Lyaung reclining Buddha, an eminent teaching center for hundreds of monks from neighboring regions and the Mon-style Shwemawdaw Pagoda, 374 feet (114m) tall, higher than Shwedagon Pagoda in Yangon.Lunch at local restaurant and after lunch drive to Kyeikhtiyo.

"Kyeik Htiyo" means "pagoda upon a hermit's head". It is the most attraction for tourists. It is famous for Kyeikhtiyo pagoda on the top of gilded boulder by devotees and like a precariously perched on the edge of a hill. Arrive Kyeikhtiyo Base camp at the foot of the hill, takes a truck to Mt. Yathe and then Mt. Yathe to the Golden Rock. Arrive hill top, walk to Pagoda otherwise you can offering food & fruit to Pagoda and can do meditation at flat ground around a pagoda. Overnight at Kyeikhtiyo.



After breakfast at hotel drive down to the base camp and return to Yangon. On the way visit to Allied War Cemetery in Htauk Kyant - final resting place of thousands of Allied Soldiers who perished during the World War II campaign in Myanmar. After that drive back to Yangon and visit one of the world's most spectacular monuments, the Shwedagon Pagoda; Shwedagon has become the symbol of Myanmar. Dinner at local restaurant. After Dinner transfer back to hotel. Overnight at hotel in Yangon .



After breakfast at hotel visit to Yangon Colonial Style city center. **Sule Pagoda**" With unique architectural features 2000 years old, is located in the center of Yangon near **City Hall** and Mahabandoola Independent Monument Park, within a traffic circle. So, you can see "Window sightseeing". Heading to **Botatung Pagoda**;

It's the history too that makes this pagoda particularly interesting. "Bo" translates to "military leaders" and "tataung" is the word for 1,000. The story goes that 1,000 military officers welcomed Buddha relics, including a hair, that were brought from India to Burma more than 2,000 years ago. After that visit to "Chaukhtathgyi Pagoda" it is the fourth largest colossal reclining image in Myanmar and 67m long. "Shopping at Bogyoke Market (Scott) Market" with hundreds of food, clothes, handicrafts and gems stores. Then transfer to airport for departure to your home.
