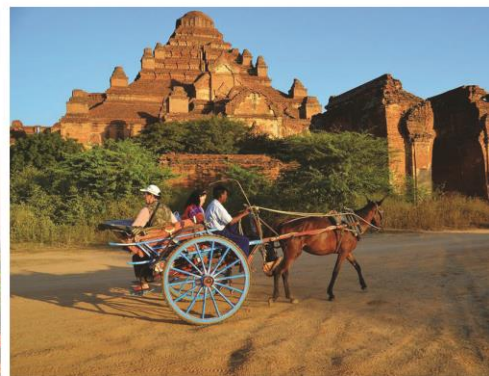


Bagan has been named as a UNESCO World Heritage Site



4 Days Yangon - Bagan - Popa - Yangon Tour

Day 01 : Arrive Yangon – Yangon Sightseeing (-/ L/D)

Upon arrival to Yangon , meet and welcome by our Yangon station guide and visit downtown area to see **Sule** pagoda located on a roundabout in downtown Yangon ,**Yangon City Hall** of Myanmar architectural design ,**High Court** noted for its British colonial architecture including its red-bricked exterior. Then visit to **Chaukhtatgyi Reclining Buddha Image** - houses the fourth largest colossal reclining Buddha image. You can study traditional wood carving workshops along the stairways of this pagoda. If time permit, shopping at the **Bogyoke market** formerly "Scott market", where you can get a wide range of Myanmar handicraft, jewelries, fabrics, lacquer wares and so on (Note : Market is closed on Mondays and public holidays) .Finally , visit to **Karaweik Hall** , a royal barge in the form of Karaweik (mythical bird) built in 1972 in the Kandawgyi Royal Lake.

Lunch & Dinner at local restaurants. Overnight at Yangon.



Day 02 : Yangon – Bagan by Morning flight – Bagan sightseeing (B/L/D)

Pick up from hotel by our driver and transfer to airport. Take a flight to Bagan. Upon arrival, welcome by our guide & driver and sightseeing from the **Nyaung-U market** where you can browse many of the local handicrafts, clothes and souvenirs. Continue the sightseeing with **Shwezigone Pagoda** - in which an emerald image of the Buddha from China and the Frontlet Relic of Buddha were enshrined, **Gubyaukgyi Temple** - is noted for its wall paintings, **Htilominlo Pagoda** - one of the largest temples of Bagan is noted for its fine plaster carvings, **Ananda Temple** - the finest, largest and best preserved of all the Bagan temples , **Thatbyinnyu Pagoda** - Bagan's tallest temple at almost 217 ft, **Shwesandaw pagoda** - is a graceful white pyramid-style pagoda with steps leading past five terraces to the circular stupa top, with good 360-degree views, **Dhammayangyi Pagoda** - extending approximately 255 feet on each of its four sides, is Bagan's most massive shrine . Finally, visit to **Bupaya or Bu Pagoda** - situated right on the river bank of the Ayeyarwaddy was a favorite place to watch the sunset. Especially for the sunset in the vicinity of Bagan's ancient monument.

Note : It is not permitted to climb the Bagan temples as of January 2018.

There are some artificial hills/mounds which have good sunrise and sunset views.

Lunch and Dinner at local restaurants. Overnight at hotel in Bagan.



Day 03 : Bagan – Popa – Bagan (B/L/D)

Morning after breakfast, visit to **Mt. Popa**, 50 km away from Bagan and it is popularly recognized as an abode of many "Nats"(spirits of ancient ancestors). In the days of old, it also used to be referred to as the "**Mountain of Spirits**". The evidence of these beliefs is abundant in the form of "nat shrines", legends, rituals, ceremonial offerings, annual representative festivals, and the never- ending stream of pilgrims and believers in mysticism. Return back to Bagan and visit to **The Nathlaung Kyaung**, the only



remaining Hindu temple in Bagan, **Myazedi Pagoda**, well known for its stone inscription which, was engraved in 4 languages as in Myanmar, Mon, Pali, and Pyu on 4 sides of a stone. **Kyansithar Umin or the tunnel** was built in the late thirteenth century, **Nagayon Pagoda** was built at the end of the 11th century and it resembles the Indian temples of the area of Orissa. After visit, transfer to airport. Take an evening flight to Yangon. Upon arrival, welcome by our guide and visit to the magnificent **Shwedagon Pagoda**, the massive bell-shaped golden spire covered with 60 tons of gold plates. Enshrined with the Lord Buddha's eight hairs relics, built over 2500 years ago.



Lunch & Dinner at local restaurants. Overnight at Yangon.

Day 04 : Yangon – Departure (B)

Morning after breakfast, pick up from hotel by our driver and transfer to airport for departure.
