

## 4 DAYS YANGON – BAGO – KYEIKHTIYO [LHVD-309]

Valid to 30<sup>th</sup> June 2018

### Day 1. Arrive Yangon

Arrive in Yangon , Yangon, formerly known as Rangoon, is still a relatively quiet and charming city. Its impressive colonial and spiritual heritage makes Yangon one of the most fascinating and authentic capitals of South-East Asia. Our guide meet and greet at the airport and transfer to hotel. Free time leisure at Hotel.

Overnight at hotel in Yangon.

### Day 2. – Yangon Kyaikhtiyo ( Breakfast )

Breakfast at hotel and meet with guide at the hotel. And then trip to Kyeikhtiyo. On the way Bago city sightseeing, Kyaik Kha Wung Kyaung , “Shwethalyaung Pagoda” Built in 994 AD by King Mingadippa, It is 55 meters long and 16 meters high, another biggest reclining Buddha image in Myanmar built during 9th century. “Shwe Maw Daw Pagoda” was originally built by the Mon to a height to 23 meters in the 8th century and was rebuilt higher several times until it finally reached its present 114 meter stature in 1954, the highest pagoda in Myanmar. After sightseeing lunch at local restaurant . After lunch and drive to Kyeikhtiyo. Arrive Kyeikhtiyo and Kimpum Base to Hill top by open truck. After an hour mountain drive, arrive to hill top truck station, Then Hotel check in and take a short rest. After refreshing, Worship Kyeikhtiyo Pagoda and enjoy sunset beauties on Hill Top. Night stop at Kyeikhtiyo.

### Day3. Kyaikhtiyo -Yangon ( Breakfast )

After breakfast at hotel, take a half hour walk to a small cave. Also stop at the roadside shops for rare product of jungle. Midmorning, drive down to the base camp and return to Yangon. On the way Bago City sightseeing again, Visit “Kanbawzathardi Palace” is the famous palace of King Bayinnaung (1551-1581 A.D.) is being extensively excavated and some buildings are being rebuilt. visit “Kyeik Pun Pagoda” was built by King Dhamma Zedi in 1476 A.D, four gigantic Buddha images all in sitting posture facing the four cardinal points of the compass. Htauk Kyauk War Cemetery. Then return back to Yangon. Arrive Yangon, transfer to hotel.

Overnight at hotel in Yangon.

### Day 4 Yangon Sightseeing and departure ( Breakfast )

Breakfast at hotel .First visit to Colonial style city center. Then visit to “Shwedagon Pagoda” is the most popular pagoda in Yangon, also known to the Buddhist world as the first pagoda on the earth and the pagoda is one of the main tourist destinations in Myanmar. Visit “Chaukhtat Gyi Pagoda” it is the fourth

largest colossal reclining image in Myanmar. “Sule Pagoda” With unique architectural features 2000 years old, is located in the center of Yangon near City Hall “Shopping at Bogyoke Market (Scott) Market” with hundreds of food, clothes, handicrafts and gems stores; was built in 1926. After sightseeing, transfer to airport for departure from Yangon by International Flight.
