

5 DAYS YANGON-KYAIKHTIYO-PHA AN- MAWLAMYINE [LHVD-401]

Day 1. Arrive Yangon

Arrive in Yangon , Yangon, formerly known as Rangoon, is still a relatively quiet and charming city. Its impressive colonial and spiritual heritage makes Yangon one of the most fascinating and authentic capitals of South-East Asia. Our guide meet and greet at the airport and transfer to hotel. Free time leisure at Hotel. Overnight at hotel in Yangon.

Day 2. Yangon – Kyaikhtiyo (Breakfast)

After breakfast at the hotel. Meet with guide at the hotel and trip to Kyaikhtiyo .After proceed to Kyeikhtiyo is one of Myanmar’s landmarks, which is famous for its precarious position and religious important. Kyaikhtiyo the “Golden Rock”, a huge boulder completely covered by gold leaf and delicately balanced on the edge of a cliff. Arrive at the base camp of Kinpun and proceed to the Golden Rock by open truck about an hour mountain drive. Take a light trekking on the summit through bamboo forest. Enjoy sunset beauty on hill top. After sightseeing drive to Yangon. Arrive Yangon , dinner at local restaurant. And then , transfer to hotel.

Overnight at hotel in Kyaikhtiyo.

Day 3. Kyaikhtiyo-Pha an-Mawlamyine (Breakfast)

Breakfast at hotel and proceed to Pha an 3hr drive from Kyaikhtiyo. Arrive Pha an and a visit to Longbini Garden with 1120 Buddha images in sitting postures and then caves of Kawgoon, famous for its countless Buddha images, stalagmites and stalactites.. And then proceed to Mawlamyine and Mawlamyine sightseeing transfer to Hotel . Overnight at hotel in Mawlamyine.

Day 4. Mawlamyine-Yangon (Breakfast)

Largest Reclining Buddha Death Railway War Memorial Cemetery Have breakfast at hotel, trip to Mudon City and sightseeing at the world's largest Reclining Buddha Image located at Win Sein Taw Ya Forest. Then, return back from Mudon to Mawlamyine and proceed to Yangon. On the way, visit Thanbyuzayat- an Allied War Memorial Cemetery. Arrive Yangon and transfer to Hotel. Overnight at hotel in Yangon.

Day 5. Departure Yangon (Breakfast)

Have breakfast at hotel. After breakfast first visit to Shwe Dagon Pagoda” one of the wonders of the World. Colonial style city center. “Chaukhtathgyi Pagoda” it is the fourth largest colossal reclining image in Myanmar and 67m long. “Sule Pagoda” With unique architectural features 2000 years old, is located in the center of Yangon near City Hall and Mahabandoola Independent Monument Park, within a traffic circle. So, you can see “Window sightseeing”. Then transfer to hotel for check in and take a short rest. Then “Shopping at Bogyoke Market (Scott) Market” with hundreds of food, clothes, handicrafts and gems stores. ,” After sightseeing transfer to airport for departure by international flight.
