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**Detailed Program**

**Day 01: Arrival Yangon (D)**



Arrival at Yangon international airport and be welcomed by your personal tour guide. Start Yangon sightseeing with a visit to **Chauk Htat Gyi Pagoda** (one of the largest reclining image of Buddha in Myanmar) to see a huge reclining Buddha image. Then, enjoy the sunset at **Shwedagon Pagoda** (its golden stupa covered with 60 tons of pure gold), famous worldwide – its golden stupa is the Heart of Buddhism Myanmar. The Pagoda is believed to be 2,500 years old and the central stupa in surrounded by dozens of intricately decorated buildings and statues. There are always

many Myanmar People praying and making offerings at Shwedagon, and it's fascinating place to spend time watching the world go by. **Enjoy International Buffet Dinner at Karaweik Palace with cultural show.** And transfer to the hotel for check in .Overnight at hotel in Yangon.

**Day 02: Yangon – Thanlyin – Yangon (B, L, D)**



After breakfast at Hotel, transfer to Thanlyin (Syriam), once a trading port occupied by the Portuguese in early 17th Century. The 270 meter long bridge spanning the Bago River made possible the 45 minutes drive from Yangon. The old buildings still stand in the evidence of the days of Portuguese occupation. **Kyaik Khauk Pagoda** and **Kyauktan Yele Pagoda** in the creek are worth visiting. Visit Thanlyin which had been the base for the notorious Portuguese adventurer Philip De Brito between 1500s and early 1600s. He ruled over Thanlyin

for about 13 years. Actually, he was officially a trade representative for Rakhine (Arakan), but he ran his own little kingdom in Thanlyin, siding with the Mon in their struggle against the Burmese. In the year 1599, he occupied Bago, but in 1613, the Bama King Alaungpaya besieged Thanlyin and impaled him and

King Natshin Naung to death. King Alaungpaya destroyed Thanlyin completely in the year 1756. Today, nothing of this ancient city is to be seen. There are two tombs of Minister Padetha Raza and the great soldier-poet Natshin Naung, King of Ratus. Lunch at local restaurant. Evening stroll along **China Town area** and **night market** to see the ways of local people life. Dinner at local restaurant and overnight stay at hotel in Yangon.

**Day 03: Yangon Sightseeing (B, L, D)**



Breakfast at hotel. After that start City tour in Yangon, includes **Sule Pagoda** in the heart of the city, **Mahabandula Park (Independent Monument)**, and **City Hall**. After that, visit **Kandawgyi Royal Lake** to take a photograph towards **Shwedagon pagoda**. Lunch at local restaurant. After lunch, shopping at **Bogyoke Market** (formerly known as Scott’s market, closed on Monday) it is one of the best for souvenir shopping paradise. In the late afternoon, visit Colonial buildings downtown such as High court, Myanmar Port Authority, General Post office and

India quarter. Dinner at local restaurant and overnight stay at your hotel in Yangon.

**Day 04: Yangon Sightseeing and Departure (B)**

After breakfast at the hotel, If time permit, we bring you to **an authorized gems and jewelry shop** where you can pick up a wide variety of precious things. Transfer to Yangon International Airport for departure flight to conclude this unique experience.
