Day 4: Bagan – Yangon by flight, sightseeing (B, L, D)

Day 5: Yangon International Departure (B)

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Detailed Program

Day 01: Arrival Yangon (D)



Arrival at Yangon international airport and be welcomed by your personal tour guide. Start Yangon sightseeing with a visit to **Chauk Htat Gyi Pagoda** (one of the largest reclining image of Buddha in Myanmar) to see a huge reclining Buddha image. Then, enjoy the sunset at **Shwedagon Pagoda** (its golden stupa covered with 60 tons of pure gold), famous worldwide – its golden stupa is the Heart of Buddhism Myanmar. The Pagoda is believed to be 2,500 years old and the central stupa is surrounded by dozens of intricately decorated buildings

and statues. There are always many Myanmar People praying and making offerings at Shwedagon, and it's fascinating place to spend time watching the world go by. **Enjoy International Buffet Dinner at Karaweik Palace with cultural show.** And transfer to the hotel for check in .Overnight at hotel in Yangon.

Day 02: Yangon – Bagan by flight, sightseeing by car (B, L, D)



After breakfast at the hotel, early morning flight to Bagan (domestic schedule flight, ~ 1 ½ hour flying) situated in Central Myanmar, on the East bank of the mighty Ayeyarwaddy River, to discover its glorious past and histories. Arrive at Nyaung U Airport and transfer to hotel for check. Tour highlights include **colorful Nyaung Oo Market**, and **Shwezigon Pagoda** – built by King Anawrahta in the early 11th century as a religious shrine, then go to **Ananda Temple** – King Kyansittha's masterpiece and the crowning achievement of the early style temple of

architecture, next is **Thatbyinnyu Temple** – the highest building on the Bagan plain, after that visit to **Htilominlo Temple** – the largest temple of Bagan – noted for its fine plaster carvings and glazed

sandstone decorations. Lunch at local restaurant. In the afternoon observe the process of traditional lacquer ware, one of Myanmar's best known handicrafts and a specialty of Bagan. Then visit **Myingabar Gubyaugyi Temple** – an early period Pyu-style temple of Hindu influence with some of the oldest mural paintings in Bagan and **Dhamanyangyi Temple** noted for its remarkable brickwork. Lastly enjoy the sunset over the Ayeyarwaddy River from **Shwesandaw Pagoda**. Dinner at local restaurant. Overnight at hotel in Bagan.

Day 03: Bagan – Mt. Popa – Bagan sightseeing by car (B, L, D)



After breakfast, this morning make an excursion to **Mt.Popa** which rose from the ground in a massive earthquake in 442 BC. Mt. Popa is famous as the abode of the Nats (Spirit Gods) and for its panoramic view of the local tropical region. On the way to Mt.Popa, visit a **toddy palm juice** production plant. Lunch at local restaurant. In the afternoon, visit a **lacquer-ware factory**. As the day wanes, you will take a horse cart right through the temples to **Bupaya**, a Pyu style stupa which is located right on the banks of the Ayeyarwaddy River and from

where you begin a scenic boat ride ending at **Lawkananda Pagoda**, a riverside stupa where you can catch another magnificent sunset. Dinner at local restaurant. Overnight in Bagan.

Day 04: Bagan – Yangon by flight, sightseeing by car (B, L, D)



After breakfast at the hotel, transfer to the airport for flight back to Yangon (Domestic schedule flight, 1 ½ hour flying). On the way to the hotel, visit **Sule Pagoda** (landmark of Yangon), **Mahabandula Park (Independent Monument)** and **City Hall**. And then shopping at **Bogyoke Market** (Scott's Market) of hundreds of shops where you can find local products such as Gems & Jewelry, slippers, cloth, and so on. Evening stroll along the **China Town** to study the ways of living of Yangon citizens (which

can observe the tradition and modern costume). Dinner at local restaurant and overnight stay at hotel in Yangon.

Day 05: Yangon Sightseeing and Departure (B)

After breakfast at the hotel, if time permit, we bring you to **an authorized gems and jewelry shop** where you can pick up a wide variety of precious things. Transfer to Yangon International Airport for departure flight to conclude this unique experience.
