Brief Itinerary

Day 1: Yangon Arrival (D)

Day 2: Yangon – Bagan by flight, Sightseeing by car (B, L, D)

Day 3: Bagan Morning Hot Air Balloon ride, sightseeing by car (B, L, D)

Day 4: Bagan – Mandalay by flight, Amarapura Sightseeing by car (B, L, D)

Day 5: Mandalay – Yangon by flight, Sightseeing by car (B, L, D)

Day 6: Yangon International Departure (B)

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Detailed Program

Day 1: Yangon Arrival (D)

Arrival in Yangon international airport, welcomed by tour guide and transfer to the hotel. Then visit Temple of Chaukhtatgyi reclining Buddha. Enjoy the sunset at Shwedagon - "Its stupa with gilded gold leaves is the « heart » of Buddhist Myanmar. The pagoda is believed to be 2,500 years old and the central is surrounded by dozens of intricately decorated buildings and statues. There are always many Myanmar people praying and making offerings at Shwedagon, and it's a fascinating place to spend time watching the world go by". Dinner at local restaurant. Return to your hotel. Overnight stay at hotel in Yangon.

Day 02: Yangon – Bagan by flight, Sightseeing by car (B, L, D)

After breakfast, early morning flight to Bagan (domestic schedule flight, ~ 1 ½ hour flying) situated in Central Myanmar, on the East bank of the mighty Ayeyarwaddy River, to discover its glorious past and histories. Arrive Nyaung U Airport. Whole day sightseeing of Bagan's most important temples and pagodas ranging from the temples with the earliest wall paintings to the prototype pagoda the influenced the designs of later Buddhist monuments. Tour highlights include colorful Nyaung Oo Market, and Shwezigon Pagoda – built by King Anawrahta in the early 11th century as a religious shrine, then go to Ananda Temple – King Kyansittha's masterpiece and the crowning achievement of the early style temple of architecture, next is Thatbyinnyu Temple – the highest building on the Bagan plain, after that visit to Htilominlo Temple – the largest temple of Bagan – noted for its fine plaster carvings and glazed sandstone decorations. Lunch at local restaurant. In the afternoon observe the process of traditional lacquer ware, one of Myanmar's best known handicrafts and a specialty of Bagan. Then visit Manuha Temple, Myingabar Gubyaugyi Temple – an early period Pyu-style temple of Hindu influence with some of the oldest mutual paintings in Bagan and Dhamanyangyi Temple noted for its remarkable brickwork. Lastly watch sunset over the Ayeyarwaddy River from Buphaya or Shwesandaw Pagoda. Dinner at local restaurant. Then transfer to hotel for check in and overnight at hotel in Bagan.

Day 03: Bagan Full Day Sightseeing by car (B, L, D)

Option: Balloon over Bagan (BOB)

It is a unique opportunity to see the Bagan with 'BALLOONS OVER BAGAN'. You get a magnificent birds-eye view of thousand year-old pagodas, temples and the mighty Ayeyarwaddy River as it has never been seen before. The balloon is guided by gentle winds not exceeding 24 km/h. Eight/Six passengers plus a pilot fit into the balloon's basket. The champagne flights at sunrise last just under an hour and take off daily from October through March. Price is US \$ 300/ pax (rate is not included in the quotation). Due to the limited capacity, advance bookings at an early stage are highly recommended.

After breakfast, visit tropical village to visit an old Noodle Cottage and observe the daily life the people in Taung Bi Village. Lunch at local restaurant. Afternoon visit Kyaukgu Umin Temple, which is an interesting rock cave tunnel, and Nagayon, an elegant and well preserved temple containing many Buddha images, the main one which is twice life size and shelters under the hood of a huge serpent. In the evening, enjoy the sunset by boat along Ayeyarwaddy River. Overnight at hotel in Bagan.

Day 4: Bagan – Mandalay by flight, Amarapura - Mandalay Sightseeing by car (B, L, D)

After breakfast at the hotel, transfer to the airport for flight to Mandalay (domestic schedule flight, ~ 30 minute flying) - the commercial centre and cultural tourism site, was established in 1857 by King Mindon, Arrive at Tada Oo International airport and direct sightseeing to the ancient city of Amarapura. We next visit the Mahagundayone Monastery and observe the daily life of the monks. This is a great opportunity to take some memorable photos of the monks as they parade for their daily meal. We travel a short distance to the U Bein Wooden Bridge that crosses the Taung Tha Man Lake. At 1.2km long it is the world’s longest teak bridge. Then we proceed to Mandalay. Lunch at local restaurant. Sightseeing includes Shwenandaw Monastery, and then Kuthodaw Pagoda, which is famous as the world largest book of many stone on which is inscribed the world Buddhist Literature. Then visit the great sage Mahamuni Pagoda and Shwe Inn Bin Monastery. Dinner at local restaurant. Transfer to hotel for check-in and overnight stay at hotel in Mandalay.

Day 5: Mandalay – Yangon by flight, Sightseeing by car (B, L, D)

After breakfast, transfer to airport for flight back to Yangon. Upon Arrival, transfer to hotel for check-in. (Upon room available). Lunch at local restaurant. In the afternoon, shopping at Bogyoke Market (Scott’s Market) of hundreds of shops where you can find local products such as Gems & Jewelry, slippers, cloth, and so on. And evening walk along the China Town to enjoy local people way of life. Dinner at local restaurant. Return back to hotel and overnight stay at hotel in Yangon.

Day 6: Yangon International Departure (B)

Breakfast at hotel. Then transfer to Yangon international airport to fly back to your home to conclude unique service.
