Day 2 – Yangon

Meal Plan (B/-/-)

After breakfast, start to visit Karaweik Hall known as a royal barge on the royal lake for the fantastic photo view and continue on visit Chaukhtatgyi colossal reclining Buddha Image.

Then transfer to city center to take a walking tour in downtown to observe the colonial styled red-brick buildings built by the British during 1900s. You can observe Yangon at its fabulous mix of architecture and sites.

In the afternoon, proceed to Shwedagon Pagoda, which is claimed to be the world richest golden stupa of two thousand five hundred years old. The golden dome rises 98 meters above its base and is covered with 60 tons of pure gold. Enjoy fantastic sunset view from the hilltop. Overnight in Yangon.

Day 3 – Yangon-Mandalay

Date: TBD

Meal Plan (B/-/-)

Breakfast at hotel and transfer to airport for your Mandalay bound flight.

Upon arrival at Mandalay proceed to Kyawzun jetty, observe water buffaloes working with Myanma superlative teak wood and busy riverside activity. Board on privately chartered boat for Mingun across Ayeyarwady River. Observe Mingun bell, the world's largest ringing bell weighing 90 tons. Other tour highlights are Settawya Pagoda with a marble foot print of Buddha and Pahtodawgyi, an enormous pile of bricks is all that remains of King Bodawpaya's grandiose scheme Mingun Village and Shinbume Pagoda, most attractive pagoda built in 19 century.

In the afternoon, stroll around the foot of Mandalay hill to observe Shwenandaw (Golden Palace) Monastery which is the finest example of Myanmar wooden art and Kuthowdaw Pagoda which claims to house the world's largest book of Buddhist scripture. We will end our day at Mandalay hill enjoying a fantastic sunset view from the hill.

Breakfast at hotel and visit Phayagyi to pay homage to the most revered Mahamuni Image and continue to ancient capital of Amarapura "meaning city of immortality" where the country's largest monastery, Mahagandayon Monastery is located. Observe the lunch process of hundreds of Buddhist monks. Then continue to Sagaing, covered with 600 white-painted pagodas and monasteries, widely regarded as the religious center of Myanmar and is home of 3,000 monks and 100 meditation centers. Observe fantastic sunset from unique 200 years old U Bein wooden bridge. Return to Mandalay.

Day 5 – Mandalay-Bagan	Date: TBD	Meal Plan (B/-/-)

Early morning transfer to airport for your Bagan bound flight to Bagan.

Upon arrival, we will transfer to hotel for a short freshen up. Then we depart to visit Gawdawpalin, one of the largest and most imposing monuments in Bagan, Anandar Temple and the best preserved masterpieces of Mon architecture. Then we continue to visit Dhammyangyi, the temple of evil king for the unique of double Image of Buddha.

In the afternoon, visit traditional Lacquer-ware workshop to observe the process of making unique Myanmar souvenir. Enjoy sunset view from one of the ruins. Overnight in Bagan.

Day 6 – Excursion to Mt Popa	Date: TBD	Meal Plan (B/-/-)

After breakfast at the hotel, depart to Mt. Popa for approximately one and half hours. Mt. Popa is an extinct volcano with its shrine dedicated to animist spirits, known as "nats". On the way observe local daily life activities such as toddy palm juice extracting, sweet ball <brown sugar> making process and hand drill edible oil production etc. For the energetic it is time to climb the 777 steps to the shrine at the top of the hill. Less energetic may blend your self with local pilgrimage with their festivities at the bottom.

Return to Bagan and continue visit some of the temples such as Nandarnannya with their unusual architecture and tantric Buddhism influence. Enjoy the sunset from one of the ruins. Overnight in Bagan.

Day 7 – Bagan-Kalaw

Breakfast at the hotel and drive to Kalaw (approx. 8 hour) via a twisting and turning hilly drive through Shan plateau. After a long day drive you will feel cool comfortable to arrive at hill station town. Free time for your day ahead. Overnight in Kalaw.

Day 8 – Kalaw Trekking

Date: TBD

Meal Plan (B/L/-)

After breakfast at the hotel, depart to start the trekking from Kalaw to Nyaung Gone village (approx. 3 hour) through pine trees, local village and tribal agriculture business such as tea plantation, sesame plantation, Chayote vine yard etc. Lunch in Nyaung Gone village and continue trek to Ywa Thit (approx. 1 hour). Observe cheroot leaves plantation for Myanmar Cigar manufacture, tea leaf making process and the ways of life and proceed to Taryaw village (approx. 15 min). Visit local Buddhist monastery and famous Palaung traditional long house where multiple families are living together under same roof. Return to Kalaw via view point for the bird-eye view of Shan plateau. Overnight in Kalaw.

Day 9 – Kalaw –Inle Lake

Date: TBD

Meal Plan (B/-/-)

After breakfast at the hotel, drive from Kalaw to Inle Lake. Upon arrival, board on a traditional long and tall motorized boat for a sightseeing tour of the lake. You will have a chance to observe unique leg rowing fishermen, floating firms which are built up from strips of water hyacinth and mud which anchored to the bottom with bamboo poles, houses and monasteries on the tilt.

Visit famous Phaungdaw Oo pagoda housing five sacred and almost shapeless Buddha images, and cottage industries. In the afternoon, continue to visit floating village of Ywama, the lake's downtown, the weaving village of Inpawkhon and the Ngaphechaung, a museum like monastery where old belongings of many monasteries are restored. Overnight in Inle Lake

Day 10 – Inle Lake

Date: TBD

Meal Plan (B/-/-)

After breakfast at the hotel, we will enjoy visiting the 5 days rotating market to observe a colorful market. Then we continue to Indein which is one of the small villages of Inlay Lake located on the western bank of the lake. Start to walk and visit Na Daung Kya village which is famous for typical cracker made with sticky rice flour and explore to village for their bean, corn plantation as well as a daily village life.

Proceed to visit a complex of about 1,000 stupas of varying sizes built between the 17th and 18th centuries. We can enjoy wandering around these overgrown ruins. (Lunch break)

Continue to trek to Nay Daw village (approx. 1 hour) which is little village of where Pa Oh tribes are settled. Observe around the village where they grow garlic and beans. Board on your boat and back to hotel. Overnight at Inle Lake. Overnight in Inle Lake

After breakfast at the hotel, transfer to Heho airport for your bound flight to Yangon. Upon arrival, continue visit Bogyoke market, a famous shopping center to enjoy display of Myanmar superlative handicraft and Botataung Pagoda said to have enshrinement of Buddha hair relic. Continue to explore Yangon as it starts to come alive as market stalls open, people finish work and take to the streets for their evening rituals. With explore local markets, China town and local street food and finish up at what is known locally as 'BBQ Street'. Overnight in Yangon.
