

# 4 DAYS YANGON - BAGAN - INLE

**Valid Till : 30 Apr 2018**

## **Day 1: Yangon arrival and full day (No meals)**



Upon your arrival in Yangon, welcome by our tour guide and transferred to your hotel for check-in. Explore the famous architecture sites and you can see historical buildings both sides of streets. Start walking from post office and walk through the famous The Strand Hotel. Then walk along Pansodan Street with is most of the colonial buildings such as high-court, inland water transport, etc. situated. Then reach to Mahabandoola Garden and Independence Monument. Take photos there in front of Sule Pagoda. Then proceed to Scott Market which is 75 years old and major markets in town. It is known for its colonial architecture and inner cobblestone streets and dominated by antique, Burmese Handicraft and jewellery shops, art galleries and clothing stores. The market also has a number of stores for local shoppers, selling medicine, foodstuffs, garments and foreign goods. It is closed on Monday; open every other day, including Sunday.

In the afternoon visit Chauk Htat Kyi, home to a 70-meter long reclining Buddha. The feet of the statue carved with traditional symbols and often many locals gathering to pay homage and pray. Then photo stop at the Karaweik Hall royal floating barge. Then proceed to Shwedagon Pagoda which is ancient and big golden pagoda and also known as the Great Dagon Pagoda and the Golden Pagoda, is a gilded stupa which is 99-metre-tall (325 ft) pagoda is situated on Singuttara Hill to the west of Kandawgyi Lake and dominates the Yangon skyline. You can enjoy the amazing sunset from the Pagoda. Transfer back to Hotel. Overnight in Yangon.

## **Day 2: Yangon – Bagan by AM flight (B)**



After breakfast at hotel, transfer to airport for AM flight to Bagan. Upon arrival in Bagan meet at the airport and begin our exploration by visiting Nyaung U Local Market, which is a busy local market and you can see variety of local products from the villages near. Then you can explore the architectural masterpieces of this amazing town by visit to a diverse selection of the most important pagodas and temples. Visit Shwezigon Pagoda, built 1000 years ago by King Anawrahta and his successor Kin Kyan Sit Tha as religious shrine. Then visit Anada Temple which is famous for the for big Buddha standing images on each of four. Then visit Htilominlo Pagoda and transfer to hotel for check-in. In the afternoon visit Lacquer ware workshop get to learn more about the local culture seeing their techniques passed down through generations to create beautiful items. Then proceed to Manuha Pagoda. Then horse-cart riding along the pagodas for about half an hour and stop at Shwesandaw Pagoda (or) one of the highest Pagodas in Bagan to see the sunset.

Then transfer to hotel. Overnight in Bagan.

## **Day 3: Bagan – Heho-Inle by AM flight (B)**



After breakfast, transfer to airport for the flight to Heho. Fly to Heho, gateway to Inle Lake. From Heho drive to NyaungShwe where we pick our boat & transfer to your hotel for check in. Enjoy the full day tour by private boat in Inle lake. Visit the Phaung Daw Oo Pagoda, the most holy religious site in southern Shan State. Be amazed by the local handicrafts, silk weaving, wooden handlooms and traditional blacksmith methods along the way. Visiting Inle Lake is not just about being on the water but also about discovering the Shan and Intha villages on the banks of the river. Pass the endless floating gardens, houses, monasteries built on stilts on the lake. Stop at Nga Phe Kyaung Monastery then proceed to Nampan village and see local cheroot factory (where the Burmese cigars are made) and canoe carving. Overnight Inle Lake

## **Day 4: Inle –Heho -Yangon departure (B)**

After breakfast at hotel, transfer to Heho airport for the flight back to Yangon. And then take International flight for your departure.
