

5 Days Yangon - Bagan - Heho - The Lei Oo

Valid Till : 30 Apr 18

Day 01: Yangon arrival (B, -, -)



Upon your arrival in Yangon, welcome by our tour guide and transferred to your hotel for check-in. Afternoon enjoy private tour and visit famous Chauk Htat Kyi, home to a 70-meter long reclining Buddha. The feet of the statue carved with traditional symbols and often many locals gathering to pay homage and pray. Photo stop at the Karaweik Hall royal floating barge. Nothing will prepare you for Shwedagon Pagoda, with its glittering gold stupa. At the pagoda observe local pilgrims and monks offering their devotions and enjoy the amazing sunset view at Shwedagon pagoda. Overnight Yangon.

Day 02: Yangon – Bagan by AM flight (B, -, -)



After breakfast at hotel, transfer to airport for the flight to Bagan. Fly Heho – Bagan by AM flight. Upon arrival in Bagan meet at the airport and begin our exploration by visiting a busy local market and gain an insight into the bustling market atmosphere in Bagan. You will spend the day exploring the architectural masterpieces of this amazing town by visit to a diverse selection of the most important pagodas and temples. Visit Shwezigon Pagoda, built 1000 years ago by King Anawrahta and his successor Kin Kyan Sit Tha as religious shrine. Then visit Anada Temple which is famous for the big Buddha standing images on each of four. Then visit Htilominlo Pagoda and transfer to hotel for check-in. In the afternoon visit Lacquer ware workshop get to learn more about the local culture seeing their techniques passed down through generations to create beautiful items. Then proceed to Manuha Pagoda. Then horse-card riding along the pagodas for about half and hour and stop at jetty for sunset boat ride on Ayeyarwaddy River (45 Minutes Boat ride). Then transfer to hotel. Overnight Bagan.

Day 03: Bagan - Mandalay (B, -, -)



After breakfast at hotel transfer to airport for the flight to Mandalay. Upon arrival in Mandalay meet at the airport and visit Mahagandayon monastery which is the country's most prominent monastic college. The monastery, known for its strict adherence to the Vinaya the Buddhist monastic code.

Mandalay is the economic centre of Upper Myanmar and considered the centre of Burmese culture. Visit the second most sacred image in Myanmar next to the Shwedagon Pagoda is the Mahamuni Pagoda which is major pilgrimage site. Then visit local artisan's workshops of gold leaf making, woodcarving and marble carving.

In the afternoon visit Mandalay Palace which is the last royal palace of the last Myanmar monarchy. The palace was constructed, between 1857 and 1859 as part of King Mindon's founding of the new royal capital city of Mandalay. The plan of Mandalay Palace largely follows the traditional Burmese palace design, inside a walled fort

surrounded by a moat. Then proceed to Golden palace Monastery famous for its intricate woodcarvings. Continue to the Kuthodaw Pagoda, which is known as the world largest book due to the Buddhist scripture carved on 729 marble slabs. Then visit a 200-year-old teak bridge, the most photographic site in Myanmar.

Overnight Mandalay.

Day 04: Mandalay –Irrawaddy River – Mingun – Mandalay – Yangon by PM flight (B, -, -)



After breakfast at hotel, you'll board a private local boat for a trip up the Irrawaddy to Mingun (45 min each way). Visit the Mingun Bell which weighs more than 87 tons and being the world's largest intact bronze bell, the unfinished Mingun Paya (built with the intention of being the world's biggest pagoda). Mingun's other highlight is the Hisbyume Pagoda, a white-washed temple built to resemble Mount Meru. Throughout Mingun there are small neighborhoods crafting traditional basketry and other artistic items and there is plenty of time to stop and interact with the craftsmen and friendly locals.

Return to Mandalay by boat and transfer to airport for the flight back to Yangon. Fly to Yangon by PM flight.

Upon arrival in Yangon meet at the airport and transfer to hotel

After breakfast at hotel transfer to airport for the departure flight.
