Kathmandu – Nagarkot – Pokhara

About Nepal: The Himalayas or "abode of snow" is in fact the youngest and highest mountain system in the world. Nepal is located on the southern slopes of the Central Himalaya surrounded by India and Tibet. Tourism in Nepal was first promoted only in 1951. Nepal is known for exotic reputation from its incomparable blend of high mountains, rivers and rich Hindu and Buddhist culture. Lush jungles, broad valleys and rolling hills are crowned by the frozen peaks of the central Himalaya. Nepal is also known for an unparalleled concentration of the world's highest mountains, including eight of the world's fourteen 8,000 meter peaks.

ITINERARY

Day 01: SINGAPORE – KATHMANDU

Welcome Meet-and greet with garland upon arrival. Transfer to your respective hotel. Rest of the time free on your own. Overnight in Kathmandu.

Day 02: KATHMANDU – NAGARKOT (30 km, 1.30 hour)

B
After breakfast, proceed on to city tour of **Boudhanath Stupa**, where you will be able to experience the Tibetan Culture and **Swoyambhunath Stupa** on the hillock from where you can see the Kathmandu Valley, also known as **Monkey temple** and **Kathmandu Durbar Square- Kumari Temple/ Kasthmandap** and **Hanuman Dhoka** (Old Palace). Overnight in Kathmandu.

Day 03: KATHMANDU – POKHARA (210 km, 6 hours)

B
After breakfast, proceed towards **Pokhara**. Also known as **Baidham**, **Pokhara** is approx 6 hrs drive and 210 km from Kathmandu. Check into the hotel upon arrival. Boat ride on **Fewa lake**- one of the Nepal biggest Natural Lake & visit **Barahi Temple** in the middle of the lake in the evening. Overnight in Pokhara.

Day 04: POKHARA

B
Sunrise at **Sarangkot** where you will be able to see all the major peaks of **Annapurna range** including **Dhaulagiri, Annapurna I, II, V & Fishtail(Holy) Peak** also known as **Machhapuchhre**. After breakfast, proceed for city tour to **Bindebashini Temple, Mahadev Cave, Seti Gorge & Davis Fall**, also known as **Pattale Chango** and Tibetan refugee camp- A Tibetan Refugee settlement. Back to Hotel & free and easy thereafter. Overnight in Pokhara

Day 05: POKHARA – KATHMANDU

B
After breakfast, proceed towards Kathmandu, **OPTIONAL: en-route visit Manakamana Temple (Wish Fulfillment Temple)**. Arrive in Kathmandu & check in to the hotel. Overnight in Kathmandu.

Day 06: KATHMANDU – SINGAPORE

B
After breakfast, free and easy until time of departure. (Hotel Check out Time 1200 Noon). Transfer to International airport for final departure.
