Seat-in-coach touring offers a cost competitive way of travelling around the country by using a mixture of daily tourist coach services and the point to point national bus network. Commentary is usually available on the tourist coach services. All transfers to and from hotels are included. Itineraries are suitable for the Independent Traveller. Travellers who prefer to be part of one group with an escort and guided services should book a set departure Escorted Coach Tour.

Day 1 Arrive Christchurch

On arrival at Christchurch Airport will be met and transferred to your hotel.

Day 2 Christchurch - Kaikoura (180 km)

Travel across broad, braided rivers and the rich patchwork farming landscape of the Canterbury ranges. Continue up the ruggedly beautiful coastline between the surging Pacific Ocean and the steeply rising Kaikoura Ranges. On arrival in Kaikoura enjoy a Whale Watching cruise.

Day 3 Kaikoura - Blenheim - Nelson (243 km)

Travel north to Nelson via coach. Your journey will take you through the wine country and Blenheim township.

Day 4 Nelson

Free day in Nelson. The Nelson Tasman Region is known for its vibrant coastal towns, full of bustling cafes, charming boutiques and funky art galleries. Rich with spectacular scenery, three national parks are within 90 minutes of the city.

Recommended Optional Tour: Journey north to Abel Tasman National Park to cruise into Tonga Island Marine Reserve. Pause to view the antics at Tonga Island Seal Colony then land at historic Tonga Quarry Beach. Take a one hour walk over a picturesque forested saddle and around the Bark Bay waterfall trail to bays of golden beaches before the return to Nelson.

Day 5 Nelson - Punakaiki (265 km)

Travel today down the West Coast. This remote area has a ruggedly beautiful landscape of vast rainforests, gushing waterfalls and snow capped mountains. Punakaiki is famous for its Pancake Rocks and Blowholes where the surging sea has sculptured amazing shapes out of the rocks.

Day 6 Punakaiki - Greymouth (45 km) - Christchurch

This morning sees a short journey to Greymouth Railway Station. Board the scenic Tranz Alpine for one of the world's great train trips through the dramatic dry beech forests and tussock land on one side of the Southern Alps and the lush green landscapes on the other. The patchwork farmland of the Canterbury plains signals your return to Christchurch. On arrival in Christchurch you will be transferred to Christchurch Airport for your departure today.
