Itinerary Type: Seat in Coach touring itinerary for the independent traveller.

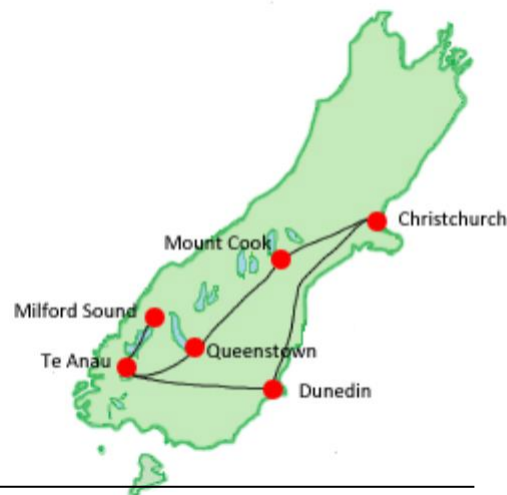

Day 1 Arrive Christchurch

On arrival in Christchurch you will be met and transferred to your hotel.

Day 2 Christchurch -Dunedin (363 km)

River crossings are a feature of the journey south to Dunedin. Set amidst a magical landscape edged by the sea, Dunedin has the finest examples of Victorian and Edwardian architecture in the Southern Hemisphere, many of which are able to be explored on foot. Dunedin's cultural riches and fine architectural heritage are complemented by a natural environment and world-famous wildlife reserves all within an easy distance of the central city.

Day 3 Dunedin -Te Anau (298 km)

Depart this morning for the Otago Peninsula to board a Monarch Wildlife cruise of the beautiful Otago Harbour. Experience unrivalled viewing of the exciting diversity of wildlife which abounds on spectacular Taiaroa Head; the only mainland nesting place for Northern Royal Albatross in the world, and home to NZ Fur Seals and eight other nesting bird species. You may also see dolphins, sea lions and a fascinating array of rarely seen ocean birds including other species of albatross, penguins and marine mammals in their natural environment. This afternoon journey across the fresh, green farming country of Southland to Te Anau.

Day 4 Te Anau - Milford Sound -Queenstown (406 km)

A full day journey into the heart of Milford Sound. Experience the world famous fjord, rich in dense rainforest, glacier carved valleys and beautiful waterfalls. Journey past the stunning Mirror Lakes and Eglinton Valley, a place of ancient alpine forest and gushing waterfalls. At Milford Sound, board your scenic cruise to see the wonders of Mitre Peak, glacier-scarred rock walls and waterfalls that tumble through valleys and crash into the sea far below. Later today continue on to Queenstown.

Day 5 Queenstown

The resort town of Queenstown is exciting, sophisticated and fantastically scenic. Today is free to enjoy the many sights and activities on offer.

Day 6 Queenstown -Mount Cook -Christchurch (594 km)

This morning travel through a mixture of high country tussock, farmland and snow capped mountains. A small side trip takes you to Aoraki, Mt Cook, New Zealand's tallest mountain where you can explore the village and soak up the view. Pass exquisite, turquoise Lake Tekapo and braided river crossings before the patchwork farmlands of the Canterbury Plains lead you into Christchurch where your tour ends this evening upon arrival at Christchurch Airport.
