## **DAY 01 – MANILA/CEBU**

Arrive Mactan International Airport

Meet and transfer to resort

Overnight accommodation

## **DAY 02 – CEBU (B)**

### **Morning – CEBU CITY TOUR**

Visit the following: FORT SAN PEDRO, is the smallest, oldest Tri-bastion fort in the country. This served as the nucleus of the first Spanish settlement in the Philippines. Depart for Magellan's Cross passing by the Heritage of Cebu monument. The HERITAGE MONUMENT, inaugurated on December 8, 2000, showcases the significant and symbolic events in the History of Cebu from the time of Rajah Humabon to the recent beatification of Cebuano Martyr Pedro Calungsod. MAGELLAN'S CROSS - marks the spot where the first Christian Filipinos were baptized. In 1525 to 1740, the Augustinian priests built an open shrine for the cross but the native began to take chips from the cross believing it had miraculous power so a kiosk like structure was built to protect the cross from total destruction. To protect it further, a hallow cross of Tindalo wood was made to encase the original cross which still stands today. BASILICA MINORE DEL STO NINO - This church was built where the image of the Sto Nino was found in 1565. The first structure of the church was destroyed by fire in 1568. Rebuilt in 1602, it was conferred the title of Basilica Minore del Santo Nino by Cardinal Antonuitte. Depart Sto Nino for Taoist Temple, En-route by Carbon Market, Avenue of the Flags, Fuente Osmena Circle, Cebu Provincial Capitol and Beverly Hills. Arrive at Taoist Temple, located in the Beverly Hills subdivision symbolized the influence of the Chinese in Cebu. It allows visitors a panoramic view of the City of Cebu

9:30 Arrive Tagbilaran, Meet and greet. Proceed with the tour immediately  
Visit Blood Compact Shrine (the marker which identifies the spot where Datu Sikatuna forges a Blood Compact with Don Miguel Lopez de Legazpi representing King of Spain, for the purpose of fostering friendly relations between the 2 Countries), Baclayon Church, one of the oldest stone churches in the Philippines And the Baclayon Musuem which contains a rich collection of religious art. Ecclesiastical vestments, librettos of church much printed in Latin on animal Skins and other priceless relics and artifacts dating back to the early 16<sup>th</sup> century. Loay Backyard Industries – see the native products made in Bohol.

12:00 River Cruise in LOBOC RIVER with lunch on a floating restaurant

2:00 Tarsier (smallest primate in the whole world viewing in Captivity), Man-made forest and visit the CHOCOLATE HILLS – Bohol’s most famous tourist attraction. There are about 1,268 perfectly cone-shaped hills which abound in Central Bohol

4:45 Visit Tagbilaran City Souvenir Shopping

6:00 Return to the Pier. Board the Fast Ferry to Cebu

7:30 Arrive in Cebu and transfer immediately to hotel
