Note:

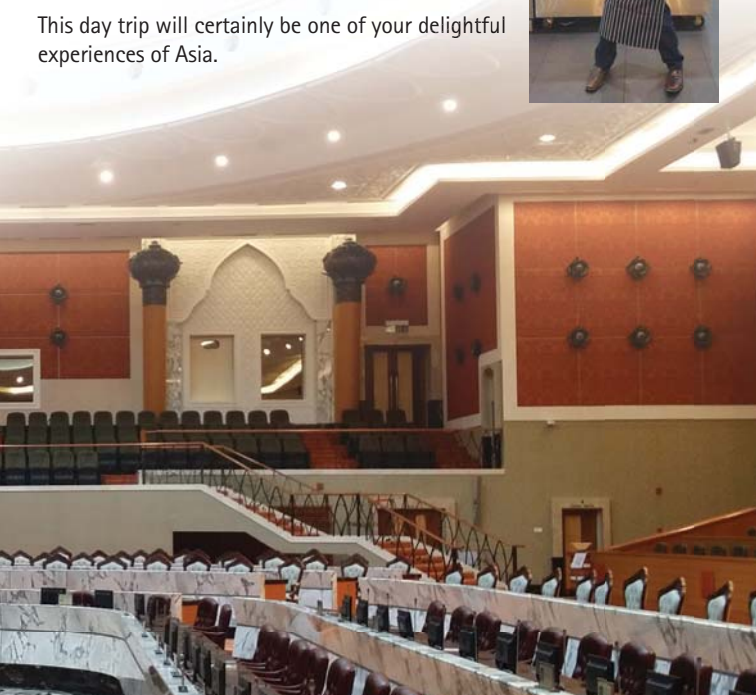
- Please check whether a visa is required for entry into Malaysia and ensure that your passport is valid for 6 months minimum.
