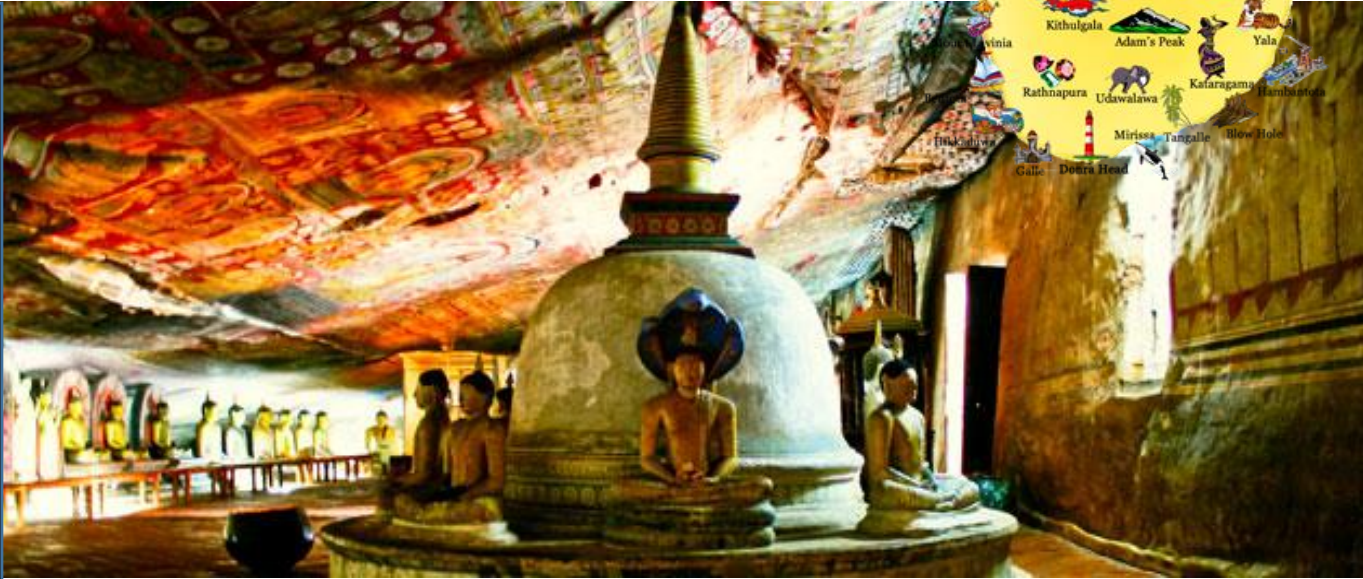

Day	City	Itinerary
DAY 01	Arrival Sri Lanka Negombo (No Meals)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Arrive in Sri Lanka. You will be met by representatives and transferred to Negombo Meet &amp; Welcome by Delmege Tours Representative at the Airport</li> <li>- Evening at Leisure</li> </ul>
DAY 02	Negombo – Polonnaruwa - Dambulla (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Breakfast at the hotel.</li> <li>- Leave for Polonnaruwa (a World Heritage Site) The second capital city of Sri Lanka built in the 11th and 12th centuries. Visit the ruins of the Royal Palace, Gal Vihare where the splendid statues of the Buddha in 'Upright', 'Sedentary' and 'Recumbent' postures are carved out of rock, Audience Hall, Lotus Bath, statue of king Parakumbahu and Parakrama Samudra - a lake built by King Parakumbahu. There are also monuments of famous places of worship such as the Shiva Temple, Lankathilake, Watadage, Golgotha, Kiri Vehera and the remains of a former Temple of the Tooth Relic.</li> <li>- Lunch at a tourist restaurant.</li> <li>- Visit Dambulla Rock Temple built by King Walagambahu, in the 1st century B.C. it is a world heritage site, and the most impressive cave temples of Sri Lanka. Major attractions are spread over 5 caves, which contain statues and paintings.</li> <li>- Dinner and overnight stay at Cultural Triangle Area</li> </ul>
DAY 03	Dambulla - Anuradhapura (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Breakfast at the hotel.</li> <li>- Proceed to Anuradhapura, the first capital of the island dating from the 4th century B.C. See the sacred Bo Tree, world famous Samadhi Buddha, the remains of the Brazen Palace and rock carvings.</li> <li>- Lunch at restaurant.</li> <li>- Visit Mihintale, the town where Buddhism first overwhelmed the people of Sri Lanka.</li> <li>- Afternoon make a jeep safari at Minneriya National Park to see the wildlife.</li> <li>- Dinner and overnight stay at Cultural Triangle.</li> </ul>
DAY 04	Dambulla – Matale - Kandy (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Breakfast at the hotel.</li> <li>- Leave for Kandy.</li> <li>- En route at Matale visit a Hindu temple, a batik factory and a spice garden. See how the different spices are grown and processed in Sri Lanka.</li> <li>- Proceed to Kandy. This was the last kingdom of Sri Lanka, and the hill capital. Kandy is also the venue for Annual Perahara, a pageant with over 150 elephants, dance troops, etc., annually parading the city for 10 consecutive days. Visit the Temple of The Tooth Relic, upper lake, Kandy Market area, university area &amp; the Royal Botanical Gardens in Peradeniya.</li> <li>- Lunch at restaurant.</li> <li>- In the evening witness a cultural dance show featuring traditional Sri Lankan dances including the fire dancing.</li> </ul>

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Dinner and overnight stay in Kandy.</li> </ul>
DAY 05	Kandy – Nuwara Eliya (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Breakfast at the hotel.</li> <li>- Leave for Nuwara Eliya.</li> <li>- Lunch at restaurant.</li> <li>- Drive through scenic mountains to Nuwara Eliya, well known as the “Little England”.</li> <li>- Stop at the mountains covered with tea bushes and at waterfalls.</li> <li>- Enjoy the magnificent landscape.</li> <li>- Visit a tea factory, follow the tea trails to watch the interesting process and enjoy a freshly brewed cup of Ceylon tea.</li> <li>- Dinner and stay overnight in Nuwara Eliya.</li> </ul>
DAY 06	Nuwara Eliya - yala (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Enjoy your breakfast in the misty climate of the hill country.</li> <li>- Leave for Tissa.</li> <li>- En route stop at Bandarawela and at Ella gap, enjoy the rich nature.</li> <li>- Lunch at restaurant.</li> <li>- Afternoon enjoy a jeep safari at Yala National Park to see the wild life. Yala is the largest in Sri Lanka and is home to wild elephants, wild boars, wild buffaloes, leopards, bears, deer and crocodiles. Large flocks of migratory and indigenous birds are also found here.</li> <li>- Dinner and stay overnight in Tissa / Kataragama.</li> </ul>
DAY 07	Yala - Bentota (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Start the day with a visit to well-known Hindu Temple at Kataragama.</li> <li>- Later leave for the beach resort.</li> <li>- Travel through Tangalle and Matara.</li> <li>- En route at Koggala see the stilt fishermen seated on poles mounted.</li> <li>- In Galle visit the Dutch Fort. In Hikkaduwa make a tour in a glass bottom boat to see the impressive underwater corals.</li> <li>- Lunch at restaurant.</li> <li>- Visit a Turtle Hatchery.</li> <li>- Dinner and overnight stay in your beach resort in South / West coast.</li> </ul>
DAY 08	Bentota- Colombo (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Breakfast at the hotel.</li> <li>- Leave for Colombo.</li> <li>- Lunch at restaurant.</li> <li>- Make a sightseeing tour of Colombo. Visit a Buddhist Temple, a Hindu Temple, Pettah, Cinnamon Gardens, The former British Administrative Center and Military Garrison, Sea Street, Goldsmiths quarters in the heart of Pettah, remaining Colonial area, Fort, Galle Face Green, Independence Square, BMICH, replica of the tallest standing Buddha statue at Aukana, etc. Discover the city &amp; explore the shopping malls, such as House of Fashion, Odel, etc.</li> <li>- Dinner at restaurant.</li> <li>- Transfer to the airport for onward flight.</li> </ul>
