It's famed for its ancient Buddhist ruins, including the 5th-century citadel Sigiriya, with its palace and frescoes. Sri Lanka has more than 2,550 years of continuous written history by means of the Mahawansha, and was also mentioned in several ancient Indian texts. One of the most famous is the Ramayana, in which the island, which was referred to as Lanka, was the island fortress of the king Ravana.

Itinerary

Day 1 Colombo Arrival

Welcome to Sri Lanka!

Meet and assist on arrival transfer to Colombo and enjoy a shopping and city tour.

Overnight stay at a Hotel in Colombo.

Day 2 Colombo - Pinnawela - Sigiriya OR Habarana Tour

Day 3 Sigiriya OR Habarana - Kandy Tour

After an early breakfast climb the Sigiriya Rock Fortress. Transfer from Sigiriya or Habarana to Kandy and enjoy a city tour of Kandy.

Early evening, you will visit a Kandyan Dance performance and be treated to a spectacular fire walking finale.

Overnight stay at a Hotel in Kandy.

Day 4 Kandy - Nuwara Eliya Tour

Breakfast at Hotel and complete the tour of Kandy.

Kandy is also famous for its shopping, gems and jewelry, handicrafts, batiks, silks etc. And you will have the opportunity of browsing to your heart's content. Transfer from Kandy to Nuwara Eliya visiting a Tea Estate and factory en route.

Overnight stay at a Hotel in Nuwara Eliya.

Day 5 Nuwara Eliya Tour

Nuwara Eliya is also the heart of the tea country and you can visit a plantation and a factory en route here and witness how the famous "Ceylon Tea" is brewed.
