1. AIRPORT – PINNAWALA – KANDY (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

- Arrive in Sri Lanka. You will be welcomed by a representation of Sunway Holidays & transfer to hotel in Kandy.
- En-route visit Pinnawala Elephant Orphanage App. 55 miles from Colombo, off the Colombo Kandy road is Pinnawala, where an orphanage was started in 1975 to house the wounded elephants. The number of elephants has increased to more than 65 now; including Baby Elephants brought from various parts, as well as the 23 babies born, as a result of the captive breeding program.
- Lunch at a Restaurant Western/Sri Lanka Buffet Meal.
- Continue to Kandy, en-route visit Spice Garden to see the different spices, which Sri Lanka is famous for.
- You will be introduced to different spices and shown how some of these spices are grown and processed.
- Kandy including upper lake drive, Market Square, Arts & Craft Centre, Gem museum & Temple of Tooth Relic. Kandy the hill capital, venue of the annual Perahara The last stronghold of the Sinhala Kings was finally ceded to the British in 1815.
- Kandy is an example of the Buddhism's influence in Sri Lanka today. Temple's shrines and monasteries keeping alive Buddhist traditions are everywhere.
- Visit Temple of the scared Tooth Relic ever since 4th century A.D, when the Buddha's Tooth brought to Sri Lanka hidden from sacrilegious hands by an Orissa princess. The Relic has grown in repute and holiness in Sri Lanka and throughout the Buddhist world. It is considered Sri Lanka's most prized possession.
- Witness a cultural show featuring various dance groups of Sri Lanka.
- > Dinner & overnight stay at hotel in Kandy.

2. KANDY – PERADENIYA – NUWARA ELIYA (Breakfast /

Lunch / Dinner)

- After breakfast visit Royal Botanical Gardens Peradeniya 147 acres in extent; Started in 1374 as a pleasure garden of the Kings of Gampola and Kandy.
- There are more than 5,000 species of trees, plants and creepers.
- Some rare and endemic as well as flora from the tropical world are found in the gardens.
- Spice Garden and orchid Houses are popular with tourists. There are 5 Palm Avenues beautifying the gardens, the earliest and tallest Palm Avenue (Royal Palm Avenue) was planted in 1905 and the Double Coconuts from the Seashells Island, with the largest seed of all plants in the world is one such avenue. Proceed to Nuwara Eliya. Enjoy "Tea experience", which involves a visit a plantation to observe firsthand the process, starting from the plucking field where it all begins with the picking of "two leaves and a bud" to the factory where the processing begins. Originally introduced to the island around 1850 by the British, Ceylon Tea is world famous for its high quality and has remained a major contributor to the island's economy for generations. Currently, Sri Lanka is one of largest exporter of tea worldwide. The high altitudes produce the best flavors, so Sri Lanka's hill-country is the ideal

environment to grow the most flavorsome tea. A guided tour around a Tea Factory is an enlightening experience. > Lunch at a Restaurant – Western/Sri Lanka Buffet Meal.

- Nuwara Eliya the 'Little England' of Sri Lanka is set against beautiful backdrops of mountains, Valleys, Waterfalls and Tea Plantation. It is supposed to be one of the coolest place in the island, but is it really just like an English spring day, although the temperature does drop at night.
- All around Nuwara Eliya you will see evidence of the British influence, house like country cottages or Queen Ann Style mansion.
- The Victoria Park in the middle of the town, is a lovely place for a stroll or a picnic and is also good for birding as you get some rare birds in this Park.
- > Transfer to Hotel in Nuwara Eliya.
- Dinner & overnight stay at hotel in Nuwara Eliya.

2.NUWARA ELIYA - COLOMBO (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

- After breakfast leave for Colombo.
- Lunch at a restaurant on the way Sri Lanka Buffet Meal.
- Afternoon leave for Colombo and commence a city & shopping tour in Colombo.
- Colombo a drive through the city taking you to the busy commercial areas as well as the tree lined residential, Cinnamon Gardens. Visit Fort, the former British administrative center and military garrison, Sea Street the Goldsmith's quarters in the heart of Petah, the bazaar area, where is also Hindu Temple with elaborate stone carvings and the Dutch church of Wolfendhal dating back to 1749. Also visit the BMICH, see the replica of Aukana Buddha and the Independence Square.
- Shopping in Colombo.
- Visit ODEL unlimited provide ample opportunity indulge, not only for shopping wear apparel for the whole family, but also take taste buds on a voyage of discovery.
- ▶ BAREFOOT discover yourself at Barefoot Toys Bags Clothes Handloom Fabric Sarongs Sarees Household Linen Art Photography Books Furniture Gallery Café: (Excursion will take approx.:2-3 Hrs).
- ➤ Dinner at a restaurant Sri Lankan Buffet Meal.
- Overnight stay at Colombo.

3. COLOMBO - KOSGODA - GALLE (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

- After breakfast leave for Galle.
- En route visit Kosgoda turtle Hatchery.
- Lunch at restaurant on the Way-Sri Lankan buffet meal.
- Kosgoda turtle hatchery: where you can see five species of turtles green turtles (cheloniamydas), Hawksbill turtle (eretmochelysimbricata), Loggerhead turtle (Carettacaretta), leatherback turtle (dermochelyscoriacea) and Olive Ridley turtle (lepidochesolivacea).
- The eggs collected by the villagers and fisherman are purchased by the Kosgoda hatchery and kept in sandy pens until they are hatched.
- The newly hatched ones are kept in seawater tanks and released to the sea in the check in at Hotel.
- Free & easy (you can enjoy water sports/snorkeling...etc.).
- > Dinner & overnight stay at Galle.

4.GALLE – AIRPORT (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

- Breakfast at hotel check out at 12.00 noon and sightseeing in Galle Sri Lanka's most historically interesting town is Galle. It was a major port until about 100 years, but today still handless shipping and sailing boats in the natural harbor.
- Stroll around the lighthouse and harbor or visit the old town where you can see the traditional lace makers and wood carvers and purchase some the finest souvenirs. * the Dutch fort the south coast the major city is Galle whose oldest landmark is the massive Portuguese and Dutch fort which is a "world heritage site" in which the central city is contained. But the city maybe much better older. Some scholars believe it to the "Tar shish" of the old testaments, which King Solomon sent his merchant vessels, and to which Jonah fled from the lord.
- Lunch at a restaurant western/Sri Lanka buffet meal continue to airport.
- Afternoon free for shopping for Sri Lanka Souvenir/Handy Craft & Sarees.
- Dinner at a Restaurant-CRAB MEAL.
- After Dinner transfer to the Airport for the departure flight.
