## DETAILED TOUR ITINERARY

### Day 1: APT – KANDY

Welcome on arrival at the Bandaranaike International Airport by a Sunway Holiday representative and transfer to Kandy. On arrival Sightseeing of Kandy including visits to upper lake drive, market square & Meera Makkam Mosque - situated on the Asgiriya Temple land donated to the Muslim community during the period of ancient kings of Kandy, which denotes the close communal relations between the religions. Evening enjoy a Kandyan dance performance. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Kandy.

### DAY 2: KANDY – NUWARA ELIYA

After the Breakfast make a visit to Royal Botanical Garden in Peradeniya. Leave for Nuwara Eliya, a hill country resort located 6200 ft. above sea level. En-route we visit a Tea Plantation and a Tea Factory to observe the production process of the world famous Ceylon Tea. Dinner and overnight stay in Nuwara Eliya.

### DAY 3: NUWARA ELIYA – EMBILIPITIYA

After breakfast we leave for Embilipitiya. En-route we visit the Saint Jeyalani Mosque in Kuragala, which is famous for its healing powers, dedicated to the memory of Saint Qutub Muhiyadeen Abdul Cader Jailany, who visited this site more than 1.000 years ago. Dinner and overnight stay at Embilipitiya.

### DAY 4: EMBILIPITIYA – KATARAGAMA

After breakfast leave for Kataragama. In the evening visit the Kataragama Shrine, devoted to God Skanda but venerated by people of all faiths. See the Mosque within the precincts. Dinner and overnight stay at Tissa/Kataragama.

### DAY 5: KATARAGAMA- SOUTH WEST BEACH

After a warm breakfast at the hotel we leave for Beruwala, a predominantly Muslim town. En-route we visit the Blow Hole in Tangalle and the Dutch fort in Galle. Dinner and overnight stay at hotel in South West Beach.

### Day 6: COLOMBO

After Breakfast Sightseeing of Colombo with visits to Colombo Grand Mosque - this occupies a unique place in the life of the Muslim community in Ceylon from the times of ancient Sinhalese Kings. Its early origins are hidden in the dim past where legend and tradition are interwoven with history. Its significance and position for the Muslim community has been such that even today it takes a leading role in all the religious activities of the community. Thereafter take a glimpse of perhaps the most striking building in Pettah, Second Cross Street. Built in 1909, the Jami-UI-Alfar Mosque its decorative brick- work, patterned in red and white, is conspicuous. its decorative brick- work, patterned in red and white, is conspicuous. Visit the “Colombo Malay Cricket Club” founded in 1847, which is the oldest Malay Cricket club in the world & “Akbar Town” and do short visits to a mosque, Muslim religious school, kindergarten & an orphanage.

Shopping in the City - Colombo’s primary bazaar district is Pettah, located next to the Fort District. The narrow cobble-stone streets are lined with stalls and shops that sell a vast array of fabrics, clothing, handbags, jewelry, watches, electronics, shoes, books, household items, and much more, at really great prices. Another good shopping area if you’re looking for crafts is the Laksala Emporium. Run by the government, the goods here are top-notch. Selections range from painted wooden masks and lacquer ware to batik and handloom cloth. For other high-quality items, check the Handloom Emporium, the Sri Lanka Gem & Jewelry Exchange, and the shops around the Cinnamon Gardens. Larger scale shopping is available, too, at Crescat Boulevard and Majestic City, both on Galle Road, ODEL & Beverley Street, and House of Fashion. These larger malls feature clothing stores, restaurants, supermarkets, and cinemas. Many shoppers in Sri Lanka have their eye out for the famous Ceylon tea. One safe bet is Tea Tang, with locations at Liberty Plaza, Galle Face Court, the World Trade Center, and the airport. Another good option is Mlesna Tea, with shops at Liberty Plaza, Majestic City, the Hilton, Crescat Boulevard, and the airport not forgetting Dilmah Tea. Stop at the Grand Legend, Noritake Showroom - The Legend – Leading manufacturer, exporter and retailer of high quality porcelain and ceramic products. NORITAKE export quality/grade porcelain table ware available in Tea or Dinner sets of various designs. GOLDMARK (Fine China) porcelain tableware, hand-painted ceramic tableware and collectables are also available.
