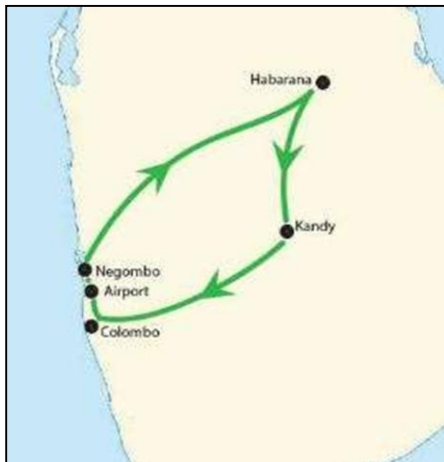


5 Days Sri Lanka Heritage (SH-AS/06(II))

1. AIRPORT – COLOMBO (Dinner)

- Arrival at Bandaranaike International Airport.
- Transfer to hotel in Colombo.
- Stay overnight at the hotel.

2. SIGIRIYA – KANDY (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Transfer to hotel in Dambulla.
- Climb Dambulla Rock Temple built by King Walagambahu, in the 1st century B.C. It is a world heritage site, and the most impressive of Sri Lanka's cave temples.
- Climb the 5th century Sigiriya Rock Fortress which is a world heritage site, built by King Kashyapa (477-495 AD).
- Stay overnight in Dambulla/Habarana.

3. MATALE - KANDY (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Proceed to Kandy.
This was the last kingdom of Sri Lanka, and the hill capital. Kandy is also the venue for Annual Perahera, a pageant with over 150 elephants, dance troops, etc., annually parading the city for 10 consecutive days. Visit the Temple of The Tooth Relic, upper lake, Kandy Market area, university area & the Royal Botanical Gardens in Peradeniya.
- In the evening witness a cultural dance show featuring traditional Sri Lankan dances including fire dancing.
- Overnight stay in Kandy.

4. KANDY – COLOMBO (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

- After breakfast visit the Elephant Orphanage in Pinnawala.
- Leave for Colombo.
- Make a sightseeing tour of Colombo. Visit a Buddhist Temple, a Hindu Temple, Pettah, Cinnamon Gardens, The former British Administrative Center and Military Garrison, Sea Street, Goldsmiths quarters in the heart of Pettah, remaining Colonial area, Fort, Galle Face Green, Independence Square, BMICH, replica of the tallest standing Buddha statue at Aukana, etc. Discover the city & explore the
