DETAILED TOUR ITINERARY

Day 1: APT - ANURADAPURA

Arrival at Bandaranaike International Airport. Welcome by a Sunway Holidays representative and Proceed to Chilaw and visit Munneswaram Temple. It is believed that Munneswaram is a significant historical place in Sri Lanka and predates the Ramayana. Sinhala, Hindu, and Buddhist devotees worship by this historical temple. Stay overnight at the hotel in Anuradhapura.

Day 2: ANURADAPURA - JAFFNA

Breakfast at the hotel. Visits to Anuradhapura (a World Heritage Site), which has a history of over 2500 years. It was the first capital and undoubtedly the grandest city of the ancient Sri Lanka. Sri Maha Bodhi (sacred Bo-Tree) was brought as a sampling of the tree under which Prince Siddhartha attained enlighten. It is over 2,500 years old and is the oldest historically documented tree in the world. At Brazen Palace (2nd Century B.C) with its 1600 stone columns see the remains of a magnificent multi-storied residence for monks. Ruwanweliseya (2nd century B.C) is the most famous of all the Dagobas and the Isurumuniya rock temple (3rd Century B.C) is known for its rock carvings. Afterwards leave for Jaffna. Stay overnight at the hotel in Jaffna.

Day 3: NALLUR - JAFFNA

After breakfast, make a visit to Nallur Temple in Jaffna. The Nallur Kandaswamy Temple was founded in 948. According to the Yalpana Vaipava Malai, the temple was developed at the site in the 13th century by Puvenaya Vaku, a minister to the Jaffna King Kalinga Magha. Sapumal Kumaraya (also known as Chempaha Perumal in Tamil), who ruled the Jaffna kingdom on behalf of the Kotte kingdom is credited with either building or renovating the third Nallur Kandaswamy temple. Visit a few selected Hindu temples from a well over 150 Hindu Temples in Jaffna. Afterwards make a city tour in Jaffna. Stay overnight at the hotel in Jaffna.

Day 4: JAFFNA - TRINCOMALEE

Breakfast & leave Trincomalee. Visits to Thirukkoneswaran Temple in Trincomalee. The Koneswaram Temple is a Hindu temple dedicated mainly to Lord Shiva. It is one of the five Sivan temples found on the island. It is believed that the temple has been there for more than 2,500 years now. Visit a few selected Hindu temples. Sri Pathrakali Temple, Sivan Temple, Sri Muthu Kumaraswami Temple, Kandaswamy Temple etc. Stay overnight at the hotel in Trincomalee.

Day 5: TRINCOMALEE- KANDY

Breakfast & Leave for Kandy the last capital of the Sri Lankan Kings. The name 'Kandy' conjures visions of splendor and magnificence. Many of the legends, traditions and folklore of Kandy are still lovingly kept alive. Visit the temple of the tooth relic, Bahirawakanda Temple which is very attractive and hilly place in the Kandy Town. This is a center for carrying out national as well as international Buddhist relations. Afterwards make visits for Gadaladeniya Temple/Embakke Temple/Lankathilaka Temples at Kandy. Stay overnight at hotel in Kandy.

Day 6: KANDY – KATARAGAMA

Breakfast at the hotel. Leave for Tissa/Kataragama. En route visits to Buduruwagala ancient Buddhist temple in Sri Lanka. The complex consists of seven statues and belongs to the Mahayana school of thought. The statues date back to the 10th century. The gigantic Buddha statue still bears traces of its original stucco robe and a long streak of orange suggests it was once brightly painted. The central of the three figures to the Buddha's right is thought to be the Buddhist mythological figure-the Bodhisattva Avalokitesvara. Stay overnight at hotel in Kataragama.

Day 7: KATARAGAMA - BEACH

Early Breakfast at the hotel. Start the day with a visit to well-known Hindu Temple at Kataragama. Later leave for the beach resort. En route visits Matara Weherahena purwaramaya is situated in the village of Weherahena in the district of Matara in the southern province in Sri Lanka. Buddhist as well as non-Buddhist lives in the world pays homage to this temple and it's very popular among the people in the world.

Afterwards make a visit to Seenigama village is situated on the south-west coast. Seenigama Devale is on a small island beyond the beach. It is believed that the God Devoldevi (a local God) is protecting his village Hikkaduwa and his people as well. Stay overnight at the hotel in Hikkaduwa.

Day 8: BAEECH - COLOMBO

After breakfast leave for Colombo. In Colombo visit the Gangarama Temple, a Hindu Temple, Pettah, Fort, Museum, Galle Face Green, Independence Square etc. Discover the city & explore the shopping malls, such as House of Fashion, Odel, etc. Evening at leisure. Overnight stay in Colombo.

Day 9: COLOMBO - AIRPORT

Breakfast at the hotel. Make a visit to Kelaniya Temple. The Kelaniya Raja Maha Vihare is one of the most sacred worshipping places of the Buddhists of Sri Lanka since it is a site made hallowed by the visit of Lord Buddha. In the past Kelaniya it was a large city and the Kelani Raja Maha Viharaya was one of the largest and one of the most beautiful temples of Sri Lanka. Afterwards Transfer to airport for onward flight.
