



6 Days Gems of Sri Lanka

(from May to October)

DAY-01 | Airport | Pinnawala | Kandy

Upon arrival at the Bandaranaike International Airport, you will be met by our Airport Representative and will be introduced to your Chauffeur Guide. Transfer from Airport to Hotel in Kandy via Pinnawala Elephant Orphanage.

Pinnawala Elephant Orphanage (Optional)

Pinnawala Elephant Orphanage is an orphanage, nursery and captive breeding ground for wild Asian elephants located at Pinnawala village, 13 km northwest of Kegalle town in Sabaragamuwa Province of Sri Lanka.



Afterwards proceed to Kandy.



Kandy is a major city in Sri Lanka, located in the Central Province, Sri Lanka. It is the second largest city in the country after Colombo. It was the last capital of the ancient kings' era of Sri Lanka.

The city lies in the midst of hills in the Kandy plateau, which crosses an area of tropical plantations, mainly tea. Kandy is both an administrative and religious city and is also the capital of the Central Province. Kandy is the home of The Temple of the Tooth Relic (Sri Dalada Maligawa), one of the most sacred places of worship in the Buddhist world.

Temple of the Tooth (Optional)

Sri Dalada Maligawa the Sacred Tooth Relic is a Buddhist temple in the city of Kandy, Sri Lanka. It is located in the royal palace complex of the former Kingdom of Kandy, which houses the relic of the tooth of Buddha. Since ancient times, the relic has played an important role in local politics because it is believed that whoever holds the relic holds the governance of the country. Kandy was the last capital of the Sri Lankan kings and is a UNESCO world heritage site mainly due to the temple of Admiral of the Fleet Lord Fisher.

DAY-02 | Kandy | Nuwara Eliya

After breakfast at the Hotel, Visit the **Peradeniya Royal Botanical Garden (Optional)**



Royal Botanical Garden, Peradeniya is situated about 5.5 km to the west from the city of Kandy in the Central Province of Sri Lanka and attracts 2 million visitors annually.^[1] It is renowned for its collection of a variety of orchids. It includes more than 4000 species of plants, including of orchids, spices, medicine all plants and palm trees.

After wards transfer to Nuwara Eliya with sightseen.

Nuwara Eliya



Nuwara Eliya is a city, in the hill country of the Central Province, Sri Lanka. The city name meaning is "city on the plain (table land)" or "city of light". The city is the administrative capital of Nuwara Eliya District, with a picturesque landscape and temperate climate. It is located at an altitude of 1,868 m (6,128 ft) and is considered to be the most important location for Tea production in Sri Lanka.

Check in to the hotel and refresh.

In the evening explore the city and enjoy around the Gregory Lake

Gregory Lake

Gregory Lake was built under the period of British Governor Sir William Gregory in 1873. This is the most prominent attraction in Nuwara Eliya and all the vistor used to come here and spent some time by the lake and relax. This was used as a place for water sports and for re-recreational activities during the British time. Gregory lake gets crowded during the April tourist season.

DAY-03 | Nuwara Eliya | Yala

After breakfast at the Hotel, transfer to Yala with sightseeing.



Check in to the hotel and refresh.

In the evening, do the safari by Jeep at Yala National Park (Optional)

With trumpeting elephants, monkeys crashing through the trees, peacocks in their finest frocks and cunning leopards sliding like shadows through the undergrowth, Yala National Park (also known as Ruhunu) is The Jungle Book brought to glorious life. This vast region of dry woodland and open patches of grasslands is the big draw of this corner of Sri Lanka, and though it's far from Kenya, a safari here is well worth all the time, effort and cost. The entrance fees are payable at the main office, which is near the entrance, some 21km from Tissa. There are a few displays here of the pickled and stuffed variety. The road from Tissa is rough but passable, although a 4WD is necessary once in the park.

DAY-04 | Yala | Bentota

After breakfast at the Hotel, transfer to Bentota.

Bentota

Bentota is a coastal town in Sri Lanka, located in the Galle District of the Southern Province, governed by an Urban Council. It is approximately 65 kilometers south of Colombo.



Check in to the Hotel & refresh.

In the evening enjoying on the Water sports activities.

Water Sports (Optional)

Bentota also forms the "Sun & Fun" water sport capital of Sri Lanka with a gamut of activities from snorkeling/scuba diving along the Barbeyrn reef running very close to the shore or to a distant ship wreck operated by PADI qualified instructors, wind surfing along the coast is sheer exhilaration as nothing beats the powerless cruise along the water, water skiing along the river dragged by an experienced boater, or for the speed freaks the jet ski along the river.

Overnight stay in the Hotel in Bentota

DAY-05 | Bentota | Colombo

After breakfast at the hotel & transfer to Colombo.



Colombo, where like many capital cities in developing countries is fast changing its face. Almost overnight, skyscrapers arise from where old buildings once stood. Yet in some parts, the old world charm is retained. For example, there is a 100-year-old clock tower and several British built colonial buildings. Other places of interest are the National Museum, Pettah bazaar - where one can shop for bargain, a Hindu and a Buddhist temple, residential areas where you find the stately homes of the affluent, the Bandaranaike Memorial International Conference Hall (BMICH)- an outright gift to Sri Lanka from the People's Republic of China.

In the evening explore the City with shopping.
