#### DAY01 ARRIVAL / CHIAGNMAI

Meet on arrival and transfer to <u>Royal Flora Garden</u> (include tram & entrance fee), or namely known as Royal Flora Ratchaphruek is a horticultural exhibition in the city of Chiang Mai where visitors can admire thousands of species of trees and flowers on 80 hectares of landscaped gardens. The park is named after Thailand's national flower Ratchaphruek (Cassia fistula or golden shower tree) with its beautiful yellow blossom. One of the park's highlights is the orchid pavilion with its countless species of orchids in many colors. Next, go to visit <u>Chiagnmai Night Safari</u> (include entrance fee) Chiangmai Night Safari is a government nature theme park which is built to promote Chiang Mai tourism regarding to the government's policy apart from arts, cultures, traditions, and the beauty of nature which are the main fascinating tourist attractions. The government also works for the promotion of Chiang Mai Airport in order to make it an international airport which will allow Chiang Mai to be the tourist center in Indo-China and Southeast Asia. (overnight in Chiangmai)

#### DAY02 CHIANGMAI / CHIANGRAI

Tour <u>Chiang Dow Cave</u> Or Tham Chiang Dao Cave, it features beautiful crystal formations which have formed due to dripping water. The cave entrance is set in a small landscaped park with a fishpond and Wat Tham Chiang Dao lies just to the right. Most of the temple buildings are of relatively recent construction though some of the ancient looking chedis on the rocks at the rear of the temple are reckoned to be up to 2,000 years old. The air inside the caves is most of the times cool. <u>Doi Angkhang National Park</u> (include entrance fee), or Ang Khang Royal Agricultural Station, is a demonstration site for planting and researching flowering plants, temperate fruit trees, vegetables and other crop under the patronage of His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej (former King of Thailand). The garden comprises temperate and winter plants of Thailand and overseas, all of which are decorated, cut and planted with the Bonsai technique. (overnight in Chiangrai)

#### DAY03 CHIANGRAI

Proceed tour Elephant Camp at Chang Puak Camp (included Elephant shows, 15mins elephant riding, Long Neck & Crocodile shows) White Temple (include entrance fee) formally known as Wat Rong Khun. Wat Rong Khun is a unique temple that stands out through the white color and the use of pieces of glass in the plaster, sparkling in the sun. The white color signifies the purity of the Buddha, while the glass <u>symbolizes</u> the Buddha's wisdom and the Dhamma, the Buddhist teachings. The temple was designed by Chalermchai Kositpipat, a famous Thai visual artist. Then go to visit <u>Singha Park</u> (include tram) Or Boon Rawd Farm, it is owed by Boon Rawd Brewery, the company who produce <u>Singha Beer</u>. Large areas of the park are still a working farm with fruit orchards and tea plantations as well as some of the original barley fields. These days though, the barley is mainly used for malted drinks and health foods. The farm is now more famous for its production of oolong tea and tours of the park provide visitors with the chance to see how the tea is grown and carefully picked. The park has also been sympathetically landscaped with trails, lakes and meadows all combining to make this an attractive destination for all visitors in Chiang Rai. Next destination is <u>Wat Huay Pla Kung</u>, which is a Buddhist moumental 9-stories Chedi (Pagoda) style temple, known for its spiritual design and its ornamental details. Residing in the temple is outstanding crafted wooden statue of Guan-Imm Bhodisatva; with a soothing surrounding. (overnight in Chiangrai)

#### DAY04 CHIANGRAI / PHAN / PHAYAO / CHIANGMAI

Tour <u>Blue Temple</u> or Wat Rong Seua Ten is a recent temple which is decorated & painted in blue color with a big Buddha statue inside the main hall. Blue color represents the Dharma, the Lord Buddha virtue code of moral that spread all over the world becomes the doctrine of logically naturalistic as the bright blue sky. This temple displays the contemporary Buddhist art that implied the Lord Buddha's doctrine. After that, transfer to <u>Phan</u>, visit <u>Wat Saikhao</u>, The temple is an astonishing multi-coloured disney-esque affair looking unlike any other temples around Thailand. It is fun kind of atmosphere that shows the entire colour pallet covering the fantastical range of stupas, chedis, shrines and halls is bright, sharp and clean and the various sculptures liberally dotted. Then transfer to <u>Phyao</u>, visit <u>Phayao Lake</u> or Kwan Phayao is a very popular spot with local tourists and is also one of the important fishing resource in the northern of Thailand. Wander down to its banks in the early morning

Wat Analayo, This temple is beautifully decorated with complex of Buddhist instruction and meditation and it was built under the direction of Thai monk Phra Kru Phaiboon, it contains many structures including a large sitting Buddha image in classic Sukhothai style: The Rattana Chedi is in the Indian Bodh Gaya style of art, whilst a Chinese-style pavilion – Kuan Yin Bodhisattva – has a Buddha image hall where a golden replica of the Emerald Buddha image is enshrined, plus others made of topaz, silver, gold, and gold-silver-copper alloy.Many other images in various postures are 'protected' by a seven-headed Naga style statue. Transfer back Chiangmai. (overnight in Chiangmai)

#### DAY05 CHIANGMAI / DEPART
