Meet on arrival and transfer to visit **Doi Suthep Temple** (include entrance fee, exclude tram fee). Phra That Doi Suthep is one of northern Thailand's most sacred temples, and its founding legend is learned by every schoolkid in Chiang Mai. The original founding of the temple remains a legend and there are a few varied versions. The temple is said to have been founded in 1383 when the first stupa was built. Over time, the temple has expanded, and been made to look more extravagant with many more holy shrines added. (overnight in Chiangmai)

DAY02 CHIANGMAI / PAI

Transfer to **Pai**, Visit **Memorial Bridge**. The Memorial Bridge over Pai river has become one of many fascinating tourist attractions of Pai. The Memorial Bridge was made of iron and was built in 1942 by the Japanese to transport weapons and provisions to Myanmar (Burma) during World War II. Today, the bridge only carries pedestrians and is commonly referred to as the Memorial Bridge with the adjacent concrete road bridge on Highway 1095 the one which vehicles use to cross the Pai River. **Coffee in love**, is a major destination on the tourist trail for both Thai & Chinese people. It is a small road side coffee shop near Pai village with nice coffee and good view. After dinner, go **to Pai Night market** for shopping. (overnight in Pai)

DAY03 PAI / CHIANGMAI

Tour **Wat Nam Hoo**, Nam Hoo Temple has been long revered by local Buddhists for its principle Buddha image, Luang Por Oon Mueng. Though the ever-flowing water in the hair bun of this Buddha image is a wonder, locals strongly believe it to be sacred. The water is drunk to get rid of sickness and misfortune, and in turn bring good luck. Legend has it that the temple was built at the wish of King Naresuan for his sister, Supangunlaya. The memorial pagoda of Supangunlaya is located behind the image hall, and photos of her, King Ekatossarot, and King Naresuan are placed in the floating pavilion for people to pay respects. **Yun Lai Viewpoint**, it is a list of 10 romantic hotspots in Thailand for photo shooting with top of mountain views & flowers. **Santichon Chinese (Yunanna Village)**, this is a village of descendants of migrants from Yunnan who still cherish many aspects of Chinese culture and traditions.

Some of the Chinese in Yunnan's village were army evacuated from China 50 years ago. The tourists can see the conservative cultures and traditions of the Yunan People such as the language, dressing, and specially the Yunnan foods that is admired among the tourists. After that transfer back to Chiangmai. (overnight in Chiangmai)

DAY04 CHIANGMAI

Tour **Elephant Camp** which you will see the elephant's performances from and get a chance to ride an elephant at your own expenses. Then visit **Orchid & Butterfly Farm** on display are a profusion of blooms of all varieties, shapes, colours and prices from a few baht for the common strains to a few hundred thousand for the rare and exotic species.

Next go to **Crocodile Farm** (include Croc wrestling Show & Croc Jumparoo Show): **Croc Wrestling Show** : watch as one of the bravest daredevils at Crocodile Adventure bars an 8-10 foot crocodile by the tail for a Thai match of man versus beast. **Croc Jumparoo Show**: The show that made Crocodile Adventure World Famous! You get to feed them lunch with chicken hung high above the water so get ready for excitement during the show. Last journey will be the **San Kham Pang Village (Home Industries)** which another well-known place in Chiangmai Thailand. The San Kham Pang Village is the major traditional handicraft center in Northern of Thailand those you can see the real creating for Thai silk, Cotton Products, Jewelry, Painting works, Umbrella and Healthy Food Products as Royal Jelly Bee or Honey etc.. (overnight in Chiangmai)
