DAY01 **ARRIVAL / CHIAGNMAI**

Meet on arrival and transfer to visit Doi Suthep Temple (include entrance fee, exclude tram fee). Phra That Doi Suthep is one of northern Thailand's most sacred temples, and its founding legend is learned by every schoolkid in Chiang Mai. The original founding of the temple remains a legend and there are a few varied versions. The temple is said to have been founded in 1383 when the first stupa was built. Over time, the temple has expanded, and been made to look more extravagant with many more holy shrines added. (overnight in Chiangmai)

CHIANGMAI / LAM PANG / SUKHOTHAI / PHITSANULOK DAY02

Transfer to Lampang visit Thung-Kwian market. It is a popular fresh market among travelers as well local people around the area. Later on, go to visit Wat PhathatLampang Luang, which is one of the best examples of Lanna style architecture in Thailand. Its viharns that are open on all sides are typical of the early Lanna style. Whereas some temples have been restored using modern materials and modern building techniques, the Wat Phra That Lampang Luang has been preserved in its original state. The temple was founded in the 13th century. Its name translates to "the temple of Lampang's Great Buddha Relic". The architecture is a mix of Lanna and Thai Lü styles. Next transfer to visit the ancient city of Thailand - Sukhothai: visit Sukhothai Historial Park, The Sukhothai Historical Park encompasses the "old" walled city of Sukhothai as well as the outlying temples around it. The inner city was enclosed by a concentric set of earthen walls. There are around a dozen or so major monuments within the inner city, including the Ramkamhaeng National Museum, which the buildings house some of the small original sculptures found during excavations of the city, as well as reproductions of several of the larger artifacts. There are a number of other important temples and historic sites scattered around outside the walls of the old city like Wat Si Chum (the most enigmatic of Sukhothai's temples. The "temple of the bodhi tree" was built in the late 13th century. the temple is the large solid building (mondop) at the rear of what remains of the main prayer hall. A single narrow slit, almost the full height of the mondop, is all that pierces the structure. Through this narrow entrance, you glimpse the serene face of a single large seated Buddha image that almost completely fills the space enclosed by the building) that should not be missed by the serious admirer of Buddhist art. Wat Mahathat, it translates as "great relic", and it is one of the oldest and most important Buddhist temples in Thailand. Wat Mahathat is built of laterite and surrounded by brick walls and a moat. The main chedi is in the characteristic Sukhothai shape of a lotus bud. It is believed to contain relics of Buddha. Two huge Buddhas reside at the entrance. Of the eight smaller surrounding chedi, the four brick ones at the cardinal points reflect Khmer style, and the four on the sides indicate Lan Na art. The niches of these smaller chedi contain 28 Buddha images and stucco reliefs which illustrate the life of Buddha. Then transfer to Phitsanulok (overnight at Phitsanulok)

DAY03 PHITSANULOK / CHIANGRAI

Tour Wat Phra Si Ra Mahathat (Wat Yai) The temple is famous for its golden Buddha image named Phra Buddha Chinnarat, considered by many to be the most beautiful Buddha image in Thailand. It is one of the most highly revered images in the country, which makes the temple an important pilgrimage site for Thai Buddhists. The temple was founded in 1357 by King Phaya Lithai, King of the Sukhothai Kingdom. The King ordered the casting of three large Buddha images to be enshrined in the newly built temple. Then go to Shrine of King Naresuan, Shrine of King Naresuan the Great stands as an ode to the biggest and the most remembered king in Thai history- King Naresuan who was also popular as 'Black prince' before he donned the responsibilities of a King in 1590. The Shrine was built in 1961 at the site of the Chan Palace - where King Naresuan the Great was born and raised. The Shrine represents the Thais' utmost respect to their beloved King who liberated the nation from Burmese power. Within the Shrine is a seated image of King Naresuan the Great pouring water from a golden container symbolizing the declaration of Ayutthaya's independence from Myanmar. and then transfer to Chiangrai. (overnight in Chiangrai)

CHIANGRAI / CHIANGMAI DAY04

Tour Golden Triangle. It is the intersection between Mekong River and Kong River which is the gate of the borders in Thailand, Burma and Laos. Then you will visit Mae Sai, the northernmost town in Thailand. It is separated from Burma only by a bridge. There are many shops selling an assortment of Myanmese shores and souvenirs. White Temple (include entrance fee) formally known as Wat Rong Khun. Wat Rong Khun is a unique temple that stands out through the white color and the use of pieces of glass in the plaster, sparkling in the sun. The white color signifies the purity of the Buddha, while the glass symbolizes the Buddha's wisdom and the Dhamma, the Buddhist teachings. The temple was designed by Chalermchai Kositpipat, a famous Thai visual artist transfer back Chiangmai. Then transfer back to Chiangmai. (overnight in Chiangmai)
