DAY

- 1 ARRIVE EDINBURGH (2 NIGHTS) Get lost in the narrow lanes of Edinburgh—the Scottish apital with a mystical air combining ancient heritage with the verve of a modern city. Spend your day at leisure delving into its rich history and embracing the warm culture of the Scots, before joining your travel companions and Travel Director for a Welcome Reception with a light meal and drinks. (WR) Hotel: Leonardo Royal Haymarket
- 2 IDINBURGHSIGHTSEEING AND FREE TIME loin your Local Specialist this morning for an ntriguing sightseeing tour of the city. Ascend Castle Rock and visit Edinburgh Castle, which watches over the surrounding city from its elevated vantage point. Stroll through the Old Town along the Royal Mile and see the stunning Palace of Holyroodhouse, before enjoying time at leisure to soak up the city's festive atmosphere. (B)
- 3 :DINBURGH ST. ANDREWS PITLOCHRY SCOTTISH HIGHLANDS (2 NIGHTS) Tread n the footsteps of the world's golfing greats and head to St. Andrews en route to the glorious Scottish Highlands. A scenic drive takes us north and across the Firth of Tay, past the city of Dundee to Pitlochry. After lunch, enjoy some free time to explore its river-side setting or join an Optional Experience to Blair Castle, the ancestral home of the Clan Murray. Our day in beautiful surrounds comes to an end with a cosy dinner at our hotel. (B, D) Hotel: Highlander
- **CULLODEN, LOCH NESS, EILEAN DONAN** CASTLE AND ISLE OF SKYE EXCURSION The ragic battlefield of Culloden is our first stop on this full-day sightseeing exploration through the Scottish Highlands "over the sea to Skye" and back. We pay tribute to the brave men who lost their lives in the Jacobite Uprising, then proceed to Scotland's infamous Loch Ness keeping a keen eye out for our ever-elusive 'Nessie'. The soul-stirring sight of Eilean Donan Castle is our last stop on the mainland before we cross the bridge to the Isle of Skye and continue our scenic drive across the enchanting Sleat Peninsula. Later, we return to the Scottish Highlands and our accommodation for the night, (B, D)
- 5COTTISH HIGHLANDS GLENCOE 3LASGOW (2 NIGHTS) Our first stop today sees us commemorate World War II history at the Commando Memorial near Fort William, from which we admire spectacular views of Britain's highest peak Ben Nevis. We journey through the volcanic ruins and precipitous mountains that lie just beyond Glencoe to see the "Glen of the Weeping". Here weremember the MacDonald clansmen who were massacred in 1692. Continuing towards the River Clyde, we arrive at our final stop for the day Glasgow. (B) Hotel: Hilton Garden Inn City Centre
- 6 SLASGOW ORIENTATION AND STIRLING CASTLE EXCURSION Madainn mhath! While your Gaelic may be a little rusty, your orientation tour around this edgy city will be anything but. Begin your day seeing
