


IRISH HIGHLIGHTS

DAY

- ARRIVE DUBLIN AFTERNOON 1 SIGHTSEEING Tread in the footsteps of lames Joyce and Oscar Wilde, through the lyrical streets of Dublin – your launch pad to a memorable encounter with Ireland's iconic highlights. After a leisurely morning, meet a Local Specialist for a sightseeing tour with views of Trinity College, St. Patrick's Cathedral and the stately Georgian Squares. Indulge in a little Irish craic this evening, joining your Travel Director and fellow travellers for a Welcome Reception. (WR) **Hotel: Maldron Parnell Square**
- **DUBLIN GALWAY BUNRATTY LIMERICK** Ve journey to Galway, the City of Tribes, vhere we'll see its stone cathedral on the banks of the Corrib and spend some free time exploring its colourful façades. Irish traditions and heritage are explored next, during a visit to Bunratty Castle and its Folk Park, a living history museum that reveals insights into life in Ireland during the 18th and 19th centuries. Be sure to drop into Mac's for a pint and meet the Bean an Ti and try to spot a fairy. Then, it's on to Limerick, our home for the night. Spend a free evening enjoying the world-renowned hospitality of the Irish. (B) Hotel: Greenhills
- .IMERICK CLIFFS OF MOHER -(ILLARNEY (2 NIGHTS) This morning view he 13th-century King John's Castle overlooking the Shannon, St. Mary's Cathedral and the Treaty Stone during your orientation in Limerick. Our next stop is the spectacular Cliffs of Moher and a visit to the 'Atlantic Edge' exhibition to learn about their history. After a scenic drive through the villages of Lahinch and Kilrush, we take a short ferry journey across the Shannon estuary. Our home for the next two nights is the colourful little town of Killarney. (B) **Hotel: Killarney Avenue**
- RING OF KERRY EXCURSION Circle the spectacular RingofKerry-itsemeraldgreen nills, centuries-old stone villages and vivid blue seascapes provide a soul-stirring backdrop for our leisurely drive around a beautiful coastline that has inspired writers and poets for centuries. We'll see Daniel O'Connell's Cahirciveen, the coastal village of Waterville, Moll's Gap and the Black Valley, renowned for being the last place in Ireland without electricity and telephone networks. (B)
- (ILLARNEY BLARNEY YOUGHAL -5 NATERFORD Cross the rugged Kerry Yountains and travel to Blarney Castle to kiss the stone and acquire the 'gift of the gab'. En route to Waterford, we stop in the historic seaport town of Youghal, once home to Sir Walter Raleigh. This evening we dine in our hotel. (B, D) Hotel: Marina
- NATERFORD NEW ROSS CO. WICKLOW - DUBLIN 'Dive Into Culture' and witness the enturies-old tradition of crafting fine glass at the House of Waterford Crystal. Here we will watch the talented master craftsmen in their workshop creating exquisite pieces. Our next stop is in the town of New Ross, where we'll see the monument to John F. Kennedy who

travelled to his ancestral family hometown in 1963. We'll visit the three-masted famine ship Dunbrody and 'Dive Into Culture' yet again, gaining insights into the tragic plight of the Irish emigrants who fled the potato famine during the 1800s. Continuing through County Wexford and the lush countryside of County Wicklow, we journey to Dublin stopping en route at Glenealy Farmhouse, where we'll 'Connect With Locals' over a Be My Guest dinner and meet the Fulvio family. (B, BMG, ,) Hotel: Clayton Dublin Airport

DEPART DUBLIN For now, it's time to say a ondslán abhaile to your fellow travellers as ou close the curtain on an unforgettable journey through the Emerald Isle. Airport transfers are available. Conditions apply. (B)
