

10 DAYS JORDAN with PETRA & JERUSALEM HOLYLAND PACKAGE

Day 01 DEPARUTRE/KUALA LUMPUR (MEALS ON BOARD)

Assemble at KLIA1 to check in for our flight from Kuala Lumpur to Amman (Meals on Board)

Day 02 AMMAN/JERUSALEM [B,L,D]

Arrive Amman Airport, proceed to the city for breakfast. After a rest, drive to Mt Nebo. It was here that Moses viewed the Promised Land for the first time and visit Madaba the " City of Mosaic" . After lunch drive into the Jordan Valley to cross the River Jordan at the Allenby Bridge. Continue to Jericho, the oldest city in the World. Visit Jericho Wall and Mount Temptation. Check into Hotel for a well earn rest. Dinner in Hotel

Day 03 JERUSALEM [B,L,D]

The day's touring starts at the Mount of Olives to take in the panoramic view of Jerusalem. Then visit the Pater Noster shrine, which is built over the grotto in which Jesus assembled His disciples and taught them the Pater Noster – The Lord's Prayer [Luke 11:1-4]. Walking down, the "Palm Sunday Road", to visit Dominus Flevit – "The Lord wept." It was here that Jesus wept over Jerusalem [Luke 19:41] as He foresaw the destruction of the Temple. Continue to Gethsemane, where Jesus' spent his final night. The Garden contains trees, the roots of which go back 2000 years. Visit the Church of All Nations built over a section of bedrock identified as the place where Jesus prayed alone in the garden on the night of his arrest. We drive to Bethlehem. Here you will visit the Church of the Nativity, which rests over the cave where Jesus was born and was, originally built by the Emperor Constantine in the 4th century. Visit the Shepherds' Fields where the Angel appeared to the Shepherds. Return back to Jerusalem to visit the empty Tomb of Christ for a private service at the Garden Tomb; a beautiful place to reflect on Christ's life, the Resurrection and his message. Return to hotel in Jerusalem. Dinner in Hotel

Day 04 JERUSALEM [B,L D]

Morning, visit to the Old City to walk through the Jewish Quarter. At the steps of the Southern Wall of the Temple Mount remember the presentation of Jesus at the Temple, the finding of Jesus at the Temple and the healing of the blind man in defiance of the Priests. After viewing the Western Wall(also known as the Wailing Wall) visit Mt. Zion to see the Tomb of David and the Upper room – the place of the Last Supper, Pentecost and where Jesus appeared to his disciples after His resurrection. After lunch, we walk the Stations of the Cross lead us to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre; here visit the empty Tomb of Christ. End the day, a private service at the Garden Tomb; a beautiful place to reflect on Christ's life, the Resurrection and his message. Dinner in Hotel

Day 05 JERUSALEM [B,L,D]

Drive along the Dead Sea to visit the stronghold of Masada. This mountain top fortress that King Herod built was the scene of the last stand by the zealots fighting the Romans. The impressive excavations and setting evoke a dramatic event that has become loaded with symbolism to Israelis. View Qumran where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found then enjoy a swim in the Dead Sea before returning to Jerusalem. Dinner in Hotel

Day 06 JERUSALEM/ GALILEE [B, L, D]

Start the day with a visit to the ancient port town of Jaffa, then drive through Tel Aviv and north along the Mediterranean coast to Caesarea, once capital of the Roman province. There you will see the Roman and Crusader remains and the harbor from which St.Paul was taken prisoner to Rome. Drive to Haifa and along the Mt Carmel range to see the view from Stella Maris. Elijah, defeat of the, Prophets of Ba'al. Continue along the Jezreel Valley to Galilee. End the day at the baptismal site at the mouth of the Jordan River to contemplate the baptism. Dinner in Hotel.

Day 07 GALILEE [B,L, D]

Begin this morning with a visit to the exhibit that shows a recently discovered fishing boat from the time of Christ. Then enjoy a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, where you can recall Jesus calming the waters. The day continues at the Mount of Beatitudes to mark the Sermon on the Mount, followed by visit to Tabgha where Jesus fed the crowd of 5,000. A short distance away is the site known as "Peter's Primacy," the site where, after His resurrection, Jesus met with His disciples and told Peter to "feed my lambs; feed my sheep." [John 21:9] From here visit Capernaum where Jesus began His Galilean ministry, to see the synagogue where He taught and the church built over the site of Peter's home. Later in the afternoon we visit Caesarea Philippi, also known as Baniyas, Which was a major town and sacred place during the Hellenistic, Roman, Byzantine and early Moslem eras. It was here that Peter recognized Jesus as the Messiah. Visit a Diamond Factory. Dinner is served at hotel.

Day 08 GALILEE/PETRA [B, L, D]

Today visit Nazareth, the boyhood village of Jesus, now, a bustling city. Visit the Church of the Annunciation view the cave where Jesus worked. Then to visit the Byzantine Church at Cana, where Jesus performed his first miracle at the wedding [John 2:1-11] and where some couples like to informally renew their marriage vows. Proceed to the border Jordan. Then transfer to Petra for dinner and overnight

Day 09 PETRA [B, L, D]

Today visit Petra, show you the highlights of the Nabatean city. King Aretas, mentioned in 2 Corinthians 11:32 was a Nabatean King. You will enter the city through the Siq, the narrow gorge and be rewarded with the most astonishing and dramatic monument in Jordan: the Treasury. Next there is a visit to the theatre, the tombs and façades and the colonnaded street. In the afternoon, depart for Amman for dinner and transfer to airport for departure flight
