

9D6N JORDAN & JERUSALEM HOLYLAND PACKAGE

Day 01 Departure kuala Lumpur/ (MEALS ON BOARD)

Assemble at KLIA1 to check in for our flight from Kuala Lumpur to Amman (Meals on Board)

Day 02 Amman- Allenby Bridge –Nazareth– Tiberias [B/L/D]

Arrival at Amman Queen Alia Airport and proceed for breakfast at the hotel in Amman , thereafter transfer to the Allenby bridge to cross the border to enter Israel, visit the Byzantine Church at Cana, where Jesus performed his first miracle at the wedding [John 2:1-11] Then proceed to the baptismal site at the mouth of the Jordan River to contemplate the baptism of Jesus, After lunch, visit Nazareth, the boyhood village of Jesus, now, a bustling city for the Church of the Annunciation(The announcement of Angel Gabriel to Virgin Mary of the approaching virgin Birth.) Visit St. Joseph's the carpenter and Mary's Well Then to visit the Byzantine Church at Cana, where Jesus performed his first miracle at the wedding [John 2:1-11]. Overnight at hotel in Tiberias

Day 3 Galilee (B/L/D)

After breakfast we visiting the Mount of Beatitudes (Matthew 5) we recount the "Sermon on the Mount" looking out over the Jordan Valley and the Sea of Galilee. We continue our visit to Tabgha, where the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves and fishes is commemorated in the mosaic floors of the historic Church. In the town where Jesus' ministry was centered, Capernaum, we see the remains of an early Church, the ruins of Peter's House, and walk inside of the ancient stone synagogue where Jesus preached. A classic boat ride across the tranquil waters of the Sea of Galilee recalls the miracle of walking on water and calling on Peter and Andrew to become 'fishers of men'. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias

Day 4 Mount Tabor | Bethany | Ein Karem | Jerusalem [B/L/D]

After breakfast check out and drive through the Jordan Valley towards Bethany (House of Mary, Martha and Lazarus), then we continue to Ein Karem to visit the Church St John the Baptist. Then we drive to our hotel in Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

Day 5 Jerusalem / Bethlehem [B/L/D]

We start our day with a panoramic view of Jerusalem from the Mount of Olives as the morning lends us a breathtaking view of the Holy City of Jerusalem. The Middle East flavor is strong; sounds of morning Muslim prayers are heard and the golden Dome of the Rock shimmers in the morning sun. Visit the Chapel of the Ascension (Luke 50-53), the Church of Eleona (Pater Noster) (Luke 11:1-4, Matthew 6:5-15) and walk along Palm Sunday road to Church of Domius Flevit Chapel where our Lord Jesus wept over Jerusalem (Luke 19:41-44) then we continue our descend to one of the most inspiring works of Christian architecture and art in Israel, the Church of All Nations, site of the Garden of Gethsemane (Matthew 26:36-56, Luke 22:39-53. From there we will drive to Mount Zion to visit the last Supper room (the upper room) and visit the Tomb of David. Continuing to Bethlehem, we come to the Church of Nativity where Jesus was born (John 1). We also visit the Manger Square and the Shepherd's Field, just East of Bethlehem, we learn of the announcement of the birth of Jesus. Dinner and overnight in hotel.

Day 6 Jerusalem [B/L/D]

Today will drive to the Old City and through the Dung Gate to visit the Western Wall of the Temple, currently Judaism holiest site where supplicants from around the world come to pray. We continue walking to Mount Moriah, site of the first and second Jewish temples and now the Dome of the Rock. We recall the final hours of Jesus' life at Pilate's Judgment Hall, the Chapel of Flagellation and the Arch of the Ecce Homo "Behold, the man". We walk and pray along the Via Dolorosa - the "Stations of the Cross" where Jesus carried and fell beneath the weight of his cross to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. Continue the walk to the Garden Tomb, a beautiful ambience for you to reflect on the words of God.

Then drive back to our hotel to have a dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 7 Dead Sea / Jericho [B/L/D]

Today we leave towards the Dead Sea area crossing the Judean Desert - we continue to the Dead Sea for swimming and relaxation later on we continue toward Qumran to view historical site where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. We End our day visiting the oldest city in the world Jericho dating 10000 years old. Then drive back to our hotel for dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 8 Jerusalem /Amman/ Departure [B/L/D]

Transfer to Allenby border. As you leave the Holy Land, you not only have an unforgettable lifetime experience, but also greater insights of the historical, biblical, cultural and political events of this region, meet and assist in Allenby border(Lunch) and then for City tour, and then dinner in Amman, and then transfer to Amman airport for departure
