

12 Days Southern Wonders

(Santiago de Chile - Buenos Aires – Iguazu – Rio de Janeiro)

Day 1: Santiago de Chile

Arrival. Reception and assistance at Comodoro Arturo Merino Benítez International Airport. Transfer in Private service.

Day 2: Santiago de Chile

Breakfast. Departure for the HD City Tour in regular service: We leave the hotel to visit the main attractions in Santiago. From the historical city to the modern buildings. We will pass through the Alameda Bernardo O'Higgins Ave, where's Palacio Presidencial de la Moneda, then we will walk by the streets of Huerfanos and Ahumada that take us to Plaza de Armas. Around, we will see the Cathedral, The Post Office and the Council of Santiago. After that, we'll take a look at Santa Lucia Mountain, strategic point of the city foundation. We'll continue through Parque Forestal and the Fine Art Museum. Crossing the Mapocho river, we will arrive to Bellavista Suburb, a bohemian place with strong cultural activity. Nearby is the entrance to Parque Metropolitano with San Cristobal Mountain from where we will be able to appreciate the whole city. We will finish our tour visiting the new city center, Providencia and Las Condes and Vitacura suburbs.

Day 3: Santiago de Chile

Breakfast. Free day at leisure. OPTIONAL Tour: Viña del Mar & Valparaiso.

Day 4: Santiago de Chile / Buenos Aires

Breakfast. Transfer Out to Comodoro Arturo Merino Benítez International Airport in Private service to take the flight to Buenos Aires. Arrival, assistance and reception at the airport. Transfer In to hotel in Private service.

Day 5: Buenos Aires

Breakfast. City Tour. Enjoy the city on a tour of its main attractions. This tour gives you the emotion of a multiple Buenos Aires with it's landmark: The Obelisk. We'll visit places such as Plaza de Mayo, San Martin, Alvear and avenues like Corrientes, De Mayo, 9 de Julio, among others. Historical neighborhoods: La Boca, San Telmo, fancy as Palermo and Recoleta, modern like Puerto Madero; Parks like Lezama and Tres de Febrero, business and shopping areas. Football Stadiums and many more. Hotel. Free time.

Day 6: Buenos Aires

Breakfast. Free day at leisure. OPTIONAL Tour: HD Tigre, FD Gaucho Party or Dinner & Tango Show at Esquina Carlos Gardel.

Day 7: Buenos Aires / Iguazú

Breakfast. Transfer to the National Airport for domestic flight in Private service. Arrival. Reception and assistance at the airport. Transfer in Regular service to the hotel.

Day 8: Iguazú

Breakfast. Departure to visit the Argentinean Side of the Falls (National Park fee included). After taking the Ecological train, we will visit the upper and lower walkways of the argentinean side, approaching both water falls you can almost touch. Such magnitude of wild nature gets its highest expression in "The Devil's Throat", where the tumultuous waters are countless rainbow. We recommend the OPTIONAL Tour "The Great Adventure", where passengers of the boat have a baptism under one of his waterfalls.

Day 9: Iguazú / Río de Janeiro

Breakfast. Morning tour to Brazilian Falls (National Park fee included) From this side of the border we have the optional opportunity to fly over the falls by helicopter. In the afternoon and at the scheduled time Transfer Out in regular service to the airport for the flight to Rio de Janeiro. Arrival, assistance and reception at the airport. Transfer to hotel in Private service.

Day 10: Río de Janeiro

Breakfast. This is an excellent option for those who want to visit two of the most important touristic symbols of the city: the Corcovado and Pan de Azúcar (Sugarloaf) in one day. This tour begins with a visit to Corcovado, visitors can glimpse the most beautiful postcard of Rio de Janeiro's Christ the Redeemer statue on Corcovado Mountain. The walk starts in the neighborhood of Cosme Velho (Old) from where the train cuts the Tijuca Forest, the largest urban forest in the world, on a beautiful journey will take. From the top, you have a nice view of the city, including the Guanabara Bay, the beaches of Southern Zone and the Rodrigo de Freitas Lagoon. The statue was inaugurated in 1931 and its located 710 m.a.s.l. In this place we'll have lunch (Included) in a typical churrasqueria (steak house). After lunch, we'll continue visiting the Sugar Loaf. It was at the base of Mount of the Urca (in the Tupi language, mean "high mountain, and pointy isolated") the city of Rio de Janeiro was founded in 1565 by Estacio de Sa. The visit to Sugar Loaf is done in 2 stages by a "bondinho" suspended by steel cables. The first stage connects the Red Beach with Mount Urca, located at 215 m.a.s.l and where we'll have another beautiful view of Guanabara Bay and its islands, the embankment of Flamengo, of Mount Corcovado and Rio-bridge Niterói. From the Mount of the Urca, begins the second stage to Mount SugarLoaf at 395 m.a.s.l from where you will have a unique angle of Copacabana Beach and the Fortress of Santa Cruz and some beaches at Niterói. Hotel.

Day 11: Rio de Janeiro

Breakfast. Free day at leisure.

Day 12: Rio de Janeiro

Breakfast. Transfer to the International Airport in Private service.
