

10 Days From Ice To Sun 2019

Buenos Aires (2N) + Calafate (2N) + Foz de Iguazu (2N) + Rio de Janeiro (3N)

Day 1 Buenos Aires

Arrival at Buenos Aires airport. Private transfer with driver to the hotel.

Day 2 Buenos Aires

Breakfast at the hotel. Tour of Buenos Aires, accompanied by English-speaking guide: City Tour. Buenos Aires most colourful attraction is definitely the neighborhood of La Boca. Also worth a visit is the oldest building in Buenos Aires - City Hall Cabildo, where now it is a Museum, Presidential Palace, better known as the "Pink House", and, of course, Catholic churches. The most famous avenue "Ninth of July, you will find the world's largest shopping district.

After breakfast, our guide will pick you up at your hotel for a half day city tour in Buenos Aires.

This panoramic tour will take you through the highlights of South America's most European and cosmopolitan city. We'll drive along 9 de Julio Avenue where the renowned Colón Theater and the Obelisk, symbols of our city, are located. We'll visit Plaza de Mayo, surrounded by important historic buildings like the Casa Rosada, the Cathedral and the City Hall. We'll also visit Plaza San Martin, Alvear and Plaza del Congreso. The tour will drive us along the old fashion Avenida de Mayo and the dynamic Avenida Corrientes. Explore neighborhoods filled with colors and history, like La Boca and San Telmo, and the sumptuous neighborhoods of Palermo, Recoleta and the modern Puerto Madero, a busy gastronomic and entertainment area. In the evening visit to an unforgettable tango show with dinner. (Group tour without a guide)

Day 3: Buenos Aires / Calafate

Breakfast at the hotel. Private transfer without guide to the airport to board flight to Calafate. Arrival in Calafate. Private transfer with driver to the hotel.

Day 4 Calafate

Breakfast at the hotel. Group tour to the Perito Moreno glacier with an English speaking guide.

Perito Moreno Glacier - a magnificent giant ice glacier the length of the river 100 km, a height greater than 60 m and a width of about 4 km, which is slowly slipping from the Andean peaks in the water of the Argentine Lake. Hundreds of thousands of tourists from all over the world come here to admire the spectacular sight as well as the powerful crumbling ice walls of the glacier which slowly fall under water, raising up huge waves.

Day 5: Calafate - Iguassu.

Breakfast in the hotel. Private transfer without guide to the airport to board your flight to Iguazu.

Meeting with driver and transfer to the selected hotel.

Additionally, you can book a tour of the Argentine side of the waterfalls (U\$185/pax) Excursion to the Argentine waterfalls with a guide. We will take a walk to the National Park and admire the waterfalls from special viewing platforms located high above them. Multi-toned jets of water form a huge number of waterfalls of various shapes and heights, over which colorful rainbows hang. Impressions of this spectacle will remain with you for life. Particularly impressive is the waterfall, named Devil's Throat, which is the largest of the waterfalls. The national park covers an area of 55,500 hectares in which unique flora and fauna, which are diverse and unique to this region, are preserved.

Day 6: Iguassu.

Breakfast. Excursion to the Argentine waterfall with a guide.

The Falls are one of the great natural wonders of the world and located in the National Park with its unique flora and fauna, on the borders of Brazil, Argentina and Paraguay. The area is on the UNESCO World Heritage List, which consists of 275 separate falls; the highest fall, which is called "Devil's Throat", reaches 70m, which is 1,5x the height of the Niagara Falls. It represents one of the most beautiful tourist destinations in the planet and it has unrivalled natural richness. The Argentinean side is different from the Brazilian; you will walk on paths through the falls which give you the opportunity to have a look under the falls. You feel the strength of the falling water from up close and enjoy the 55.500 hectares natural park surrounding this spectacular beauty! Within the park, take the train to the marvelous devils throat the strongest of all the waterfalls. Stand directly above the falling water and admire the strength of this natural phenomenon.

Day 7 Iguassu - Rio de Janeiro

Breakfast in the hotel. Transfer to the airport with a driver to board your flight to Rio de Janeiro.

Arrival at the airport of Rio de Janeiro, where our English speaking guide awaits us. Transfer to the hotel. The rest of your day is for your leisure to get first impressions of Rio de Janeiro. Enjoy yourself somewhere in between palm trees, sand and the ocean waves.

Day 8 Rio de Janeiro.

Breakfast at the hotel. Half-day excursion to the Sugar Loaf with a guide. The first stop is the mountain Urca, with wide viewing area, where you can eat in a restaurant or have a drink at the bar. The mountain Sugar Loaf offers a beautiful view of Rio, Copacabana beach, the bay, the surrounding mountains, the islands in the ocean, bridge Niteroi, a statue of Christ.

Then you will go by car to the central regions of the old Rio, where you can admire several ancient churches, monasteries, the main cathedral of the city, as well as buildings, built in colonial style.

Day 9 Rio de Janeiro.

After breakfast we go on a city tour and visit Christ the Redeemer with an English speaking guide. Where you can admire several ancient churches, monasteries, the main cathedral of the city, as well as buildings, built in colonial style. Arriving at the station, from where we take the cable car which takes us up Corcovado Mountain through the jungle to the top of Corcovado hill. Both sides of the railway offer spectacular views of the forest Tijuca, which is inhabited by

monkeys and other exotic animals and birds. At the top of Corcovado hill, at an altitude of 700 m above sea level, stands the symbol of Rio – The Statue of Christ the Redeemer (38 m), which was built in 1931. From the top of Corcovado you can enjoy breathtaking panoramas of the metropolis and its surroundings: Niteroi Bridge, Guanabara Bay, the Botanical Garden, the world's largest stadium Maracana, the Sugar Loaf and many other breathtaking sights.

Day 10: Rio de Janeiro

Breakfast in the hotel. Transfer from Rio de Janeiro Airport without a guide to board your international flights.
