TOUR ITINERARY

Day 1: HANOI – ARRIVAL

(D)

Upon arrival, you will be transferred to the hotel in Hanoi for check-in (after 14:00). The rest of the day at leisure.

Dinner at local restaurant.

Overnight in Hanoi.

Day 2: HANOI – HA LONG BAY

(B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel

Enjoy a morning city tour to visit some of the city's attractions including the fascinating **Ho Chi Minh mausoleum** (closed on Monday & Friday & the whole Oct & Nov, **Quan Thanh pagoda will be replaced**), **Ho Chi Minh House on stilt & one pillar pagoda**. Visit **Restored Sword lake** in the centre of modern Hanoi.

After lunch, visit **the temple of Literature**, which is regarded as the first university in Viet Nam. Proceed to **Ha Long bay**, one of Vietnam's greatest natural wonders and was recognized as World's Natural Heritage by UNESCO. On the way, stop over at ABC rest stop.

Dinner at local restaurant.

Overnight in Ha Long.

Day 3: HA LONG – HANOI – HUE

(B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel

You will take a leisure cruise on the emerald green waters of UNESCO World Heritage Site, Ha Long bay.

It includes some 3,000 islands and islets, forming a spectacular seascape of limestone pillars. Due to their precipitous nature, most of the islands are uninhabited and unaffected by human presence. Explore the **Dau Go and Thien Cung** limestone grottos. The cruise will end with a fresh seafood lunch onboard.

Then transfer back to Hanoi. Stop over at Dai Viet rest stop on the way. Proceed to the airport for your flight to Hue.

Pick up at Phu Bai airport then transfer to local restaurant for dinner.

Overnight in Hue.

Day 4: HUE – HOI AN

(B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel.

Take a boat ride to **the romantic Huong (Perfume) River** to visit Hue's well-known religious site, **Thien Mu**, a 7-storey pagoda.

Visit **Minh Mang King's Mausoleum** which was built by King Minh Mang in 1840. The mausoleum has a magnificent architecture, military statuary and elaborate decorations. It is perhaps the most beautiful ancient remains among Hue's pagodas and tombs. Next, visit the **Imperial Palace** and **Tu Duc tomb** before proceeding to Hoi An.

Enjoy dinner at a local restaurant.

Overnight in Hoi An.
