DAY 1 ALMATY (KZ)	<p>Arrival to Almaty International airport. After passing border control and collecting luggage, you will meet local guide holding your nameplate. You are going to the hotel for check-in Evening Tour to Kok Tobe, a park located at an altitude of 1,100 meters on the green hill, this place is very popular among locals and tourists. Take a ride on comfortable cable car and within 10 minutes, you are admiring the magnificent panoramic view of the city. Overnight at hotel.</p>	COACH GUIDE
DAY 2 ALMATY	<p>Breakfast at hotel. Sightseeing tour in Almaty, 10.00 – 20.00 This day you will visit the city's old center and cover one of the main sites that best highlights Almaty's history.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <i>The first stop is Park of 28 Panfilov soldiers – named after the division during WWII, formed of men from the Almaty region under command of General Ivan Panfilov. The park itself is popular among locals and guests of the city.</i> - <i>Inside the park visitors will find the eternal flame, memorials of different heroic characters, the Ascension Cathedral – Russian Orthodox wooden church that magically withstood a strong earthquake in XX century,</i> - <i>Museum of musical instruments, where you can admire the collection over 1000 exhibits including rare exhibits dating back to XVII century.</i> - <i>Just in a walking distance, you can enjoy another touristic attraction of Almaty – “Green Bazaar” or Green market. This is a perfect way to experience the true Eastern market, where you can find main delicacies of different nations living in Kazakhstan.</i> <p>Then we stop for lunch at local restaurant. After lunch, you are going to explore the city's main attractions – the Ili Alatau mountains. Medeo is an essential part of the Ili Alatau Park and it is a historical object of Almaty's development as a city. Located at the height of 1,690 meters, the Medeo skating rink is the highest rink location in the world. However, our main purpose of visit is Shymbulak – a mountain resort located at the elevation of 2,260 meters above sea level. In 1950s, ski lovers used to climb the mountain for 3 hours for a 15 minutes' descent. Nowadays, it is a developed resort with high-level equipment and infrastructure. The place is very popular throughout the year offering not only slopes for skiing and snowboarding, but also many other services, like horseback or bike riding, hotels and restaurants, trekking etc. After you will visit the only falcon farm in Kazakhstan – “Sunkar”, where you will enjoy a spectacular show with specially trained hawks - hunting with them is one of the unique features of the Kazakh way of life. Five species of predators including golden and bold eagles, owl, vulture and falcon take part in the show and interact with the spectators. Overnight at hotel.</p>	COACH GUIDE MEALS: B
DAY 3 ALMATY BISHKEK (KZ-KRG) 240km/4-5h	<p>Breakfast at the hotel. Visiting Central State Museum The Central State Museum of Kazakhstan is the largest museum in Almaty, Kazakhstan, and one of the largest museums in Central Asia. Time for lunch. Transfer to Kazakh-Kyrgyz border “Korday”, pass border control. Meeting with guide and driver of Kyrgyz part, and drive to Bishkek. Check in to hotel and have some rest. Optionally: dinner in the local restaurant with Folklore group (no dance) performance. Overnight at hotel.</p>	COACH GUIDE MEALS: B

DAY 4 BISHKEK BURANA BISHKEK	<p>After breakfast – check-out.</p> <p>09.00 Start short sightseeing tour in the capital:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <i>Central Square Ala-Too, Change of the Guard of Honor,</i> - <i>Old Square, Oak park with the open-air sculpture gallery,</i> - <i>Art Gallery, main statues and monuments of the city center, main governmental and cultural building of the capital, Victory and Philharmonic Square also will be visited.</i> <p>Afternoon drive to Burana architectural complex, that is the ruins of the medieval city Balasagyn with its famous Burana tower (IX-XII AC), situated at 75 km from Bishkek. Once it was one of 3 capitals of Karakhanid Empire and one of the most developed cities during the golden ages of the Great Silk Road. Visit the small museum, Burana Tower and watch a collection of Balbals, Turkic ancient tombs.</p> <p>Drive back to Bishkek. Overnight at hotel.</p>	COACH GUIDE MEALS: B
DAY 5 BISHKEK TASHKENT (KRG-UZ)	<p>Breakfast at Hotel. Check-out.</p> <p>Today you will have a trip to Ala-Archa National Park, located 40 km from Bishkek.</p> <p>Ala-Archa is an alpine national park in the Tian Shan Mountains, established in 1976. The close location of the gorge allows getting the place within one hour from Bishkek city, within this time you will rise from 750 to 2100 meters above sea level. The name Ala-Archa is translated as Bright Juniper from Kyrgyz as the whole gorge is covered with various trees including the main one - juniper. Ala Archa is a perfect place to spend a day walking and or hiking in the gorge.</p> <p>Drive back to Bishkek and continue to the airport to take flight to Tashkent / time to be advised.</p> <p>Arrival in Tashkent. Transfer to hotel. Overnight at hotel.</p>	COACH GUIDE MEALS: B
DAY 6 TASHKENT BUKHARA 580 km	<p>Breakfast at hotel. Transfer to railway station to take bullet train Afrosiab to Bukhara (as per timetable).</p> <p>Upon arrival start sightseeing in Bukhara.</p> <p>Bukhara is one of most historically rich cities on the Great Silk Road attracting attention of thousands of people with its unique heritage.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <i>Kalon Complex consisting of Minaret, Mir-Arab Madrasah, and Mosque,</i> - <i>Trade domes, and Magoki – Attor mosque,</i> - <i>Madrasah of Ulugbek, and Madrasah of Abdul-Aziz khan,</i> - <i>Lyabi – Khauz complex: Nadir Divan Begi Madrasah and Khanaka; Kukeldash Madrasah;</i> <p>Overnight at hotel.</p>	COACH TRAIN GUIDE MEALS: B
DAY 7 BUKHARA	<p>Breakfast at hotel. Continue tour in Bukhara:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <i>Samanid Mausoleum, and Mausoleum of Chashma-Ayub;</i> - <i>The Ark Citadel, Bolo-Khauz Mosque;</i> - <i>Summer Palace of last dynasty – Sitorai Mokhi Khosa Palace, built to host family of the Romanovs, some of the objects are exclusively were brought from Russia.</i> - <i>Complex of Bakhouddin Naqshbandi;</i> <p>Free time for walking and shopping. Overnight at hotel.</p>	COACH GUIDE MEALS: B
DAY 8 BUKHARA SAMARKAND 280 km	<p>Breakfast at hotel. Drive to Samarkand by road transport / 4-5h. Upon arrival time for lunch, start sightseeing in the Capital of Great Empire of Tamerlane, the place which attracted Alexander the Great, Marco Polo, and other visitors of the world.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <i>Gur Emir mausoleum and Ruhabad Mausoleum from outside,</i> - <i>Registan Square with Ulugbek, Sherdor and Tilla Kari Madrasah,</i> - <i>Explore Colorful Siyab bazaar,</i> <p>Check in and time at leisure. Overnight at hotel.</p>	COACH GUIDE MEALS: B
DAY 9 SAMARKAND	<p>Breakfast at hotel.</p> <p>09:00 Continue tour of Samarkand:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <i>Bibi Khanum Mosque and Mosque of Khazrat Khizr from outside;</i> - <i>Shakhi Zinda Necropolis</i> - <i>Museum of Ulugbek observatory, original part of sextant</i> - <i>Konighil Crafts Center with Silk Paper and Oil Mills;</i> <p>Overnight at hotel.</p>	COACH GUIDE MEALS: B
DAY 10 SAMARKAND PENJIKENT (UZ-TJ)	<p>Breakfast at hotel.</p> <p>Transfer to Uzbekistan-Tajikistan border Jartepa (50 km, 1 h). Customs and passport control on both sides, cross the border, meet Tajik local guide and driver and continue to Penjikent (30 km, 40 min). Upon arrival start tour in Penjikent:</p>	COACH GUIDE MEALS: B

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Sarazm ruins. Sarazm one of the ancient settlement in Central Asia with 5500 years civilization. In 2010 the Sarazm was added to the list of the Human heritage by UNESCO. - Rudaki Museum, local Bazaar and mosque. - Ruins of ancient Penjikent located within 5 minutes drive from modern Penjikent. Penjikent was a major Sogdian city dating back to the 5th century and was destroyed by Arab conquerors in the 8th century. <p>Overnight at the hotel.</p>	
DAY 11 PENJIKENT DUSHANBE	<p>Breakfast at hotel.</p> <p>After breakfast drive to Dushanbe and upon arrival start sightseeing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Rudaki Park and Ismoil Somoni Square - Tajikistan United Museum includes the exhibits on history, natural history and art, Buddha in Nirvana is one of the valuable exhibits of museum. - Botanical garden-very beautiful garden with many old trees is the favorite place of Tajiks. - Bazaar- an oriental market is the most crowded place in the city <p>Overnight at the hotel.</p>	COACH GUIDE MEALS: B
DAY 12 DUSHANBE ISTARAVSHAN KHUJAND	<p>Breakfast at hotel.</p> <p>Departure through Istaravshan to Khujand. In Istaravshan (Ura Tube) visit:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Mug Tepa-situated in Ura-Tube is one of the ancient settlements in Tajikistan. It is said the city was found by Kir in the north-east boundary of the empire. - Khazrati Shoh architectural complex- consists of Khazrati Shoh mausoleum-the grave of brother of Kusam ibn Abbas, Khudayar Valami mausoleum and mosque Namozgoh. There were city cemetery and Medresse too. All these buildings belong to 19th c. - Bazaar- an oriental market where you can find everything. <p>Continue driving to Khujand. Sightseeing of Khujand:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Oriental Bazaar – the biggest bazaars of Central Asia is Payshanba bazaar, one of the interesting places in Khodjent attracting people with various sounds and tastes. - Museum of archeology and fortification – in the middle of northern part of the city there is fortress of 7-8th c. The territory of the fortress-300x200m. The city was surrounded with wall. It was destroyed several times during different conquests and last reconstruction was in 18th c. The museum was found inside the fortress. <p>Overnight at hotel.</p>	COACH GUIDE MEALS: B
DAY 13 KHUJAND TASHKENT (TJ-UZ)	<p>Breakfast at hotel. After breakfast transfer to Oybek border point (70 km, 1 h), As you cross the border, our driver will meet you on Uzbekistan side. Transfer to Tashkent. Arrival in Tashkent and after lunch start tour of Tashkent, one of the economically developed states of the Central Asian region, occupying a bit more than 11% of the territory of Central Asia.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Khast Imam Complex, which displays unique Osman Koran, thought to be the world's oldest Koran. - Ancient Chorsu bazaar, Kukeldash Madrasah from outside; - Independence square (Mustakillik) the main square of Tashkent, Amir Temur Square and Broadway; - Monument of Courage; Tashkent metro; <p>Overnight at hotel.</p>	COACH GUIDE MEALS: B
DAY 14 TASHKENT departure	<p>Breakfast at hotel. Check out from hotel till 12:00. Transfer to airport to take flight home.</p>	COACH MEALS: B
