

# 6 Days Fantastic Dubai Private Tour

## 5 nights Dubai Package Itinerary

### Day 01. Arrival transfer, meet & greet

Arrive at the airport and meet our representative who will escort you to your hotel and help you check-in. Overnight stay at the hotel.

### Day 02. Dubai City tour, Burj Khalifa 124<sup>th</sup> floor visit And Musical Fountain Show.



After breakfast, leave the hotel at 9.30am for Dubai city tour. This tour introduces both the new and old parts of Dubai. The tour commences with the new environs of Dubai, at the world renowned Atlantis hotel located at the Palm Jumeirah, a man-made island which can be spotted from space. Pass through one of the only 7-star hotels in the world, the Burj Al Arab. Moving ahead, stop at the exquisite Jumeirah Mosque, a cultural landmark of Dubai. Then, visit at the Union House, where the treaty that formed the United Arab Emirates was signed in 1971.

Dubai's Burj Khalifa, the tallest of all the buildings in the world, stands tall and proud amongst the other skyscrapers of the city. One of the major landmarks of the city, the interiors of the Burj is as majestic as the steely exterior. Take a look at the marvellous building from the inside by

joining the Dubai Burj Khalifa Tour with us. During the tour, you are shown a multimedia presentation about the history of Dubai as well as the story of the construction of the building. Once you have gathered information about this tall structure, you are taken to the 124th observatory deck (At the Top) on the fastest elevator. Here you get a chance to have a 360-degree panoramic view of the entire city of Dubai.

Then in night the most wonderful symphonic Dubai Fountain, it is a choreographed fountain system located on the 12 hectare (30 acre) manmade Burj Khalifa Lake, at the center of the Downtown Dubai development in Dubai, United Arab Emirates. It was designed by WET Design, a California-based company also responsible for the fountains at the Bellagio Hotel Lake in Las Vegas. Illuminated by 6,600 lights and 50 colored projectors, it is 275 m (902 ft) long and shoots water up to 500 ft (152.4 m) into the air accompanied by a range of classical to contemporary Arabic and world music

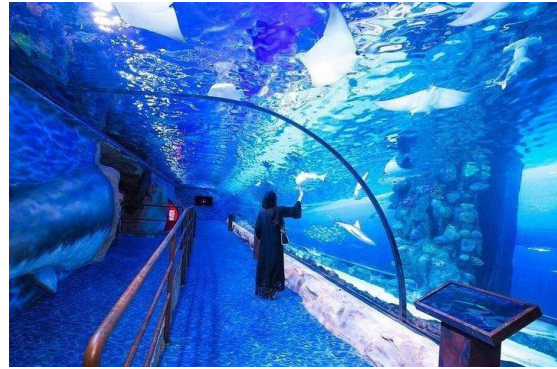


### Day 03. Dubai Mall Shopping and Under Water Aquarium & Zoo.



After breakfast, by 10:00 AM, head to Downtown Dubai, where numerous world records are located – the largest mall, the Dubai Mall. The Dubai Mall is a shopping mall in Dubai. It is the second largest mall in the world after the Iran Mall by total land area, and the 26th-largest shopping mall in the world by gross leasable area, tying with West Edmonton Mall and Fashion Island (Bangkok)—both of which are older than it. It has a total retail floor area of 502,000 square metres (5,400,000 sq ft). Located in Dubai, United Arab Emirates, it is part of the 20-billion-dollar Downtown complex (called Downtown Dubai) adjacent to the iconic Burj Khalifa, and includes over 1,200 shops. In 2011, it was the most visited building on the planet, attracting over 54 million visitors each year

Dubai Aquarium & Underwater Zoo is home to thousands of aquatic animals, comprising over 140 species. Over 400 Sharks and Rays live in our 10 million litre tank, including Sand Tiger Sharks, Giant Groupers, and a host of other marine species. A series of carefully designed experiences will allow our visitors to come face to face with our aquatic residents for memorable moments with friends and family.



#### **Day 04. Museum of the Future and Desert Safari with BBQ Dinner.**



After breakfast, by 10:00 AM, visit The Museum of the Future. Dubai is a land of marvels and one cannot get enough of it. While the tallest building, the largest mall and the largest indoor theme park, amongst other things, would keep you hooked to this marvelous city, the Museum of future, a recent addition, would surely leave you spellbound. The Museum of the future is as unique as it sounds and offers the visitors extraordinary sensory and visual experiences while being educational. The best part about this place is that unlike other museums, you do not have to be cautious about what you touch. On the other hand, this is an interactive museum and the more you touch and engage with the exhibits, the more fun you would have.

Pick up at 3.00pm from the hotel for a desert safari. A trip to the desert offers you a real adventure into the magnificent sands of the Emirates. This safari will ride through the heart of the desert by experiencing the excitement of a roller-coaster tour down the astonishing high dunes. A stop for a breathtaking view of the endless desert will provide an opportunity to watch the sunset over this tranquil scenery. Next, reach the camp and board on the 'ship of the desert' and enjoy the contrast of a desert night. Gain a unique insight into the traditional life of the Bedouins. Dress in a traditional Arabic outfit, enjoy Arabic sweets, try the 'hubbly-bubbly', henna painting and learn about the important role that falcons play in local life. A delicious BBQ dinner with grilled specialties cooked on site will be provided, with a choice between a variety of appetizers, salads and sweets. Finally, try dancing with a belly dancer to the rhythm of Arabic drums. Return to your hotel at 9.30pm.



#### **Day 05. Dubai Frame, Miracle Garden & Global Village.**



After breakfast head for The Dubai Frame, it is the new addition to the marvelous architecture the city boasts of. Consisting of two vertical towers of 150 meters height connected by a 100-square-meter bridge, the Dubai Frame is a highlight of the Dubai skyline. A tour of the Dubai Frame is a must if you do not have much time for sightseeing and also if you want to see entire city at once. The Dubai Frame has a museum and gallery where you can see the growth of Dubai from a simple fishing village to the ultra-modern city it is today with the use of photos and advanced technology. After visiting the museum, you take the elevator to the bridge to get a fascinating glimpse of the city. On one side is the charming old Dubai and on the other side is the modern new Dubai. You can also view the beautiful city while sipping delicious cup of coffee at the cafe on the bridge.

After 2 pm, we head to enjoy The Dubai Miracle Garden, which is a flower garden located in the district of Dubailand, Dubai. The garden was launched on Valentine's Day in 2013. It occupies over 72,000 square metres, making it the world's largest natural flower garden, featuring over 50 million flowers and 250 million plants. This is houses of a myriad of blooming flowers in stunning designs, many growing on spectacular shapes and structures. The Miracle Garden's 3,600-foot flower wall holds the Guinness World Record for the world's longest wall of flowers!



And by evening 5pm, head to the world-famous Global Village. At the onset of the festive season, this is the best time to visit this spot! It is known as the world's largest tourism, leisure and entertainment project located at Dubai land. Arabian Voyager brings to you the best of Global Village –the region's cultural, entertainment and tourism project with unlimited fun, excitement and adventure. From children's fun and family activities to thrilling rides; Global Village is great for entertainment! Visited by over five million people every year, The Global Village brings together the best of cultural offerings through 32 giant stalls and pavilions representing more than 75 countries with different cultures.
