Day 1: Arrive Cairo 'Welcome to Egypt'

Welcome to [Egypt](#). On this Cairo and Nile Cruise, You will be met and assisted at [Cairo](#) International Airport by a Memphis Tours Representative who will transfer you to your hotel by a private air-conditioned vehicle. Upon arrival at the Hotel, your Representative will assist you with a smooth check-in and give you detailed information concerning your pick up times during your Egypt 7 day tour. overnight in [Cairo](#).

Day 2: Giza Pyramids and Cairo Museum

Breakfast at your Hotel in Cairo and then you will be picked up by your personal expert English speaking Tour Guide who will accompany you to Giza Plateau to visit one of the seven wonders of the ancient world, [the Great Pyramids](#) of Cheops, Chefred and Mykerinus, famous [Sphinx](#) at [the Valley Temple](#) facing the great statue. Lunch will be served at a good quality local restaurant, then Continue to visit the world-renowned Egyptian Museum in Cairo that was built in neo-classical style and designed by the French architect Marcel Dourgnon. The museum's vast collection of over 120,000 artifacts ranges from pre-dynastic era, through the Pharaonic era to the Greco-Roman period of Egypt. Amongst the most famous items which you may see are the funerary treasures of the child King Tutankhamun, the colossal statues of the heretic king, Akhenaten, and the only surviving image of Khufu, creator of Egypt's Great Pyramid. Visiting the Egyptian Museum is a great introduction to learning about the ancient Egyptian civilization, including their famous art of mummification. Finally, you will be transferred back to your hotel, overnight in [Cairo](#).

Day 3: Fly Cairo to Aswan - Nile Cruise Tour

Early breakfast at your Hotel in [Cairo](#), then you will be transferred to Cairo Airport Domestic Terminal for your flight to Aswan. On arrival in Aswan, you will be met by your Tour Guide and commence your day of Aswan tours starting with [the Aswan High Dam](#) which was built in the 1960s to provide the much-needed electricity and irrigation for the country. Nubia, the area that was flooded, experienced the biggest and most thorough archaeological excavations that Egypt has ever known. Then we go to see the '[Unfinished Obelisk](#)' which still lay in the granite quarries which provided ancient Egypt with building materials. It would have been the largest piece of stone ever handled but when a crack was discovered it was abandoned where it was being hewn. Cross by boat to Angelika Island, to see [the Temple of Isis](#) at Philae which is one of the Nubian Temples rescued before the High Dam was built. Enjoy Philae's long colonnades, towers, and reliefs which include the last surviving hieroglyphic and demotic inscriptions in Egypt. You will then embark your [Nile Cruise](#) boat with time to explore the City of Aswan with dinner on board and overnight stay in [Aswan](#).

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 4: Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

Breakfast on board the Nile Cruise before Sailing to [Kom Ombo](#) to visit the Temple shared by two Gods Sobek and Haeroris in Kom Ombo (the only Temple shared by two Gods in Egypt). Lunch and afternoon tea onboard whilst sailing on to [Edfu](#). On arrival at Edfu, your Tour Guide will escort you to Edfu Temple by a Kalesh ride (horse and carriage) for an exploration of the huge Ptolemaic Temple of Horus at Edfu, which is the most complete and best-preserved of the Egyptian Temples, consisting of many columns, halls, chambers and chapels. Two statues of Horus flank the twin-towered entrance gate; and inside, one of the interesting inscriptions lists the titles of books (scrolls) held in the library Dinner on board and overnight on your Nile Cruise Ship in Edfu.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 5: Luxor Nile Cruise Tours

Enjoy your breakfast onboard your Nile cruise ship while sailing to [Luxor](#) with lunch on board the vessel, then you will be guided for a wonderful exploration of [the East Bank](#) of the Nile in Luxor to [Karnak Temple](#) the world's largest ancient religious site. The hypostyle hall with its colossal granite columns is one of Egypt's famous landmarks. There will be free time to explore the different parts of the huge complex built during the reigns of various Pharaohs. Then you will be transferred to the majestic [Luxor Temple](#) which built by [Amenhotep III](#) and Ramses II for ritual and festivals and dedicated to the God Amun. Lunch is provided through the day tours. Following lunch, you will be taken over to [the West Bank](#) of Luxor to explore West Bank of the River Nile in Luxor to the Valley of the Kings (the original resting place of the world-famous boy King Tutankhamun), and the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut (the only Female Pharaoh) at El Deir EL Bahari and the two towering statues of [the Colossi of Memnon](#). (The three tombs visited are determined by the Egyptian Government as to preserve them from the large flow of visitors, therefore are rotated throughout the year and cannot be confirmed as to which tombs prior to your visit). After the tours, you will return to your Nile Cruise for an overnight stay.

***Please Note:** There is an additional charge to enter [the Tombs of King Tutankhamun](#) and Ramses VI.

Day 6: Fly Luxor to Cairo

Breakfast on your Nile Cruise boat, then transferred around midday to Luxor Airport to [Cairo](#) International Airport, On arrival, you will be transferred back to a hotel in Cairo for an overnight stay.

Day 7: Cairo - Fly Back Home

Breakfast at your Hotel in Cairo then some free leisure time before being transferred back to Cairo International Airport for your flight back to London.
